MOTION IN LIMINE TO EXCLUDE ALLEGATIONS REGARDING CONTACT WITH SPACE COAST SOCCER CLUB

COMES NOW, the Defendant, DANA LYNN LOYD, by and through her undersigned attorney and respectfully moves this Honorable Court to enter an Order in Limine preventing the State Attorney or any State witness(es) from offering evidence regarding allegations of the Defendant DANA LYNN LOYD contacting Space Coast Soccer Club and as grounds therefore would states as follows:

- 1. The Defendant, DANA LYNN LOYD was arrested and is being prosecuted for one count of Making a False Report of Child Abuse, Abandonment or Neglect.
- 2. The Defendant DANA LYNN LOYD has been charged under Florida Statute 39.205(9) which states

"A person who knowingly and willfully makes a false report of child abuse, abandonment, or neglect, or who advises another to make a false report, is guilty of a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083. Anyone making a report who is acting in good faith is immune from any liability under this subsection."

- 3. The State has yet to file on the cyberstalking charge that the Defendant was arrested on simultaneously.
- 4. Defense Counsel believes that the State intends to offer evidence regarding allegations that the Defendant DANA LYNN LOYD contacted the soccer club in which the alleged victim, wolunteers as a soccer coach. Defense counsel believes that the State intends to offer evidence that the Defendant DANA LYNN LOYD's alleged contact with the soccer club resulted in the alleged victim receiving a suspension from coaching and an additional background check.
- 5. Defense counsel believes that the State intends to offer evidence in the form of digital recordings or statements as well as testimony from soccer club board members Scott Armstrong and/or Kevin Murtha, attorney for the soccer club.
- 6. Any allegations regarding alleged contact with the soccer club or its members are wholly irrelevant and would have occurred prior to the phone call placed on April 29, 2015, the subject of the crime in which the Defendant has been charged. Any mention of alleged contact to the soccer club would be greatly irrelevant to the crime in which the Defendant is charged.
- 7. To bring in any evidence regarding any contact between the Defendant DANA LYNN LOYD and the soccer club or its members Scott Armstrong and/or Kevin Murtha would not only be irrelevant to the crime in which the Defendant is charged, but would be improper and highly prejudicial pursuant to Sections 90.403 and 90.404 of the Florida Evidence Code.

WHEREFORE, based on the above and foregoing, the Defendant DANA LYNN LOYD, requests this Honorable Court to enter an Order prohibiting the State of Florida from bringing in any and all evidence pertaining to contact with Space Coast Soccer Club, Kevin

Murtha or Scott Armstrong or otherwise referring to in any way these alleged facts in trial of this cause.
