This publication has been reviewing the documentation attached to the February 17, 2019 shooting of an off duty BCSO deputy .

While Jacksonville nor BCSO authorities would initially identify the wounded deputy , we, to our satisfaction, have identified the wounded deputy as Deputy Jason Roberts.

We have also been advised, that the shooter of Deputy Roberts will NOT be criminally charged, due to the shooter having a viable self defense argument.

Records indicate that Deputy Roberts had involvement in the 2015 shooting incident attached to criminal defendant John DeRossett.

Mr. Derossett's trial is to start shortly, regarding his alleged participation in the shooting of Brevard County Deputy John "Casey" Smith.

We hold the OPINION that the non criminal shooting of Deputy Roberts in Jacksonville, is of significant importance, to his (Roberts) involvement in the Derossett prosecution.

Our article intends to focus on that significance.

Absent, a clarification from your office, that Deputy Roberts was NOT the deputy shot in the Jacksonville incident, we anticipate publishing our article within the next few days.
