Judicial Reassignment

## Michelle:

VolusiaExposed.Com filed a recent public record request (PRR) with the Office of the Brevard County Clerk of Court – regarding the Loyd prosecution. This morning the Clerk responded to our PRR.

On January 1, 2019 – per Judicial Administrative Order 18-33-B (see attached copy) – Loyd's case was transferred from Judge Reinman's docket to Judge Davidson's docket. The Clerk's website also reflects this docket transfer.

However, per January 8, 2019 emails between the Clerk's office and Judge Morgan Reinman (see attached copies) – Judge Reinman requested that the Loyd case be reassigned back to her docket.

While the Judicial Administrative Order (18-33-B) allows for cases to remain attached to judges "in the interest of justice and judicial economy" - this publication (VolusiaExposed.Com) would like to be advised of how Loyd's reassignment to Judge Reinman forwards either justice or judicial economy?

Given Judge Reinman's past assignment to the civil custody case attached to the Loyd case, and Loyd's recent judicial recusal requests (denied by Reinman), it is our OPINION, that Judge Reinman's request to be reassigned back to the Loyd case is at best – suspicious.
