MOTION FOR EARLY TERMINATION OF SUPERVISION

COMES NOW, the Defendant, DANA LYNN LOYD, by and through her undersigned attorney, and respectfully moves this Honorable Court for an Order granting Early Termination of Supervision in the above styled cause. For grounds, the Defendant alleges the following:

1. Ms. Loyd was found guilty by a jury on March 30, 2017, of the third degree felony crime of false report of child abuse abandonment or neglect.
2. Ms. Loyd had absolutely no criminal history in this or any other jurisdiction prior to the adjudication of guilt on this single count, and scored only 22 sentencing points.
3. Nevertheless, on April 6, 2017, Ms. Loyd was sentenced by the Hon. Robin Lemonidis to an aggregate of five (5) years supervision (two on community control, followed by three on supervised probation) AND was remanded to Brevard County Jail to serve a full year as a condition of the community control portion of her sentence.
4. Other sanctions were imposed on this first time offender, including an outrageous amount of community service hours (ONE THOUSAND).
5. Ms. Loyd, as of October 6, 2019, reached the half way point of the total amount of supervision to which she was sentenced and has, to date, performed over 500 hours of community service--an astonishing amount.

6. This Honorable Court recently dismissed the only allegation that Ms. Loyd violated her community control/probation.

7. Florida Statute 948.05(1) provides that "A court may at any time cause a probationer or offender in community control to appear before it to be admonished or commended, and, when satisfied that its action will be for the best interests of justice and the welfare of society, it may discharge the probationer or offender in community control from further supervision."

WHEREFORE, the Defendant, DANA LYNN LOYD, respectfully moves this Honorable Court for an Order granting her request for early termination of probation.
