**ORDER PROHIBITING AND EXCLUDING RECORDING DEVICES
FROM COURTROOM**

THIS CAUSE, having come before the Court upon the State's "Motion to Prohibit and Exclude Recording Devices from Courtroom" and the Court having considered said motion, testimony presented during a hearing on said motion, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, it is thereupon

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the State's Motion is granted until further order of the court. The Court finds sufficient evidence of good cause (namely a violation of sections 92.65 and 794.03, Florida Statutes) that justifies the relief requested by the State. The Court further orders that Volusia Exposed, John Bandorf, and anyone acting on the behalf of Volusia Exposed, directly or indirectly, shall not possess or use any device capable of audio or video recording inside the courtroom during the trial in this case.
