Although I currently appear in court almost daily, my time as an Assistant Public Defender (12/2003 - 6/2010) required me to be in court more frequently. Since 2010, I have represented clients in delinquency, dependency, injunctions, family, criminal, state appellate, administrative hearings, federal criminal, and civil. In domestic relations and civil cases, I have represented Plaintiffs/Petitioners and Defendants/Respondents. I have handled thousands of cases. While the majority of these cases were resolved without a trial, I have participated in many trials. Due to being in practice for nearly 17 years, I do not recall every jury trial and non-jury trial I have done. My best estimate is that I have done at least 50 jury trials and well over 100 non-jury trials. I typically handle 100% of the litigation in these cases. I have, however, litigated and tried cases with co-counsel on a number of occasions.

I believe I bring many unique contributions to this position for the following reasons:

1) First and foremost, I am a trial attorney and have litigated many cases before a jury or the bench. Therefore, I am very comfortable in a courtroom. Litigating and trying cases has made me light on my feet and able to make quick decisions, particularly in making proper objections pursuant to the evidence code. Judges must have the ability to immediately rule on objections, especially in a jury trial. Additionally, as a trial attorney, I am very familiar with how trials are conducted. My litigation experience would allow me to immediately step into the role of a judge and preside over any hearing or trial.

2) I possess a very broad range of legal experience in several different and distinct areas of law, particularly in circuit court matters. I would be very comfortable presiding over felony criminal court, dependency court, delinquency court, injunction court, family court, and civil court. There are times that different areas of law cross over or become an issue in a case. I believe I would be able to rule whether another area of law/issue is applicable in the instant case and, if applicable, make a proper ruling to the extent it is applicable.

3) I possess a great temperament. I have always been calm, courteous, professional, and respectful. That is my personality and it would not change as a judge. However, I am a confident person and capable of being firm when required. I recognize that many litigants, witnesses, and jurors have never been inside a courtroom and it can be intimidating for them, a judge should be cognizant of that issue. Additionally, I do not like seeing judges that are hostile or impatient with attorneys or litigants. Therefore, I would not treat attorneys or litigants in this manner.

4) I am hard working and prepared to work long hours as a judge. As an attorney, it can be very frustrating waiting for a ruling or trying to obtain hearing time before a judge. As a judge, I would issue rulings timely. I would also strive to manage my docket efficiently,

so attorneys and litigants can get hearing time as quickly as possible. I believe I possess a high intellect and am perfectly capable of quickly getting up to speed on legal issues or matters I have not been previously exposed to. I also possess great common sense, which is an attribute often overlooked by some jurists, but in my opinion, a critical attribute to being a great judge. As an attorney, I do try to bring some levity, when appropriate, in court or in motions. I like seeing judges do the same, when appropriate, as it does have a calming affect and makes those appearing before the court comfortable.


