Let me be very clear in saying that if you put your hands on one of my team or try to hurt them by any means, you are going to get exactly what you deserve, regardless if that is a trip to the hospital or a trip to jail!!

Earlier today, Brevard County Sheriff's Office **Animal Enforcement Officer (AEO) Hunter Reuter** responded to a residence in Palm Bay to check on the well-being of a dog that allegedly was not being properly cared for. When AEO Reuter knocked on the door, the homeowner, Renise Amisial opened the door, ordered AEO Reuter to get off her property, and then slammed the door in her face!!

AEO Reuter began to walk away from the front door, at which time Amisial re-opened the front door and threw hot water onto AEO Reuter's back, causing her to receive burns to her back area. AEO Reuters immediately called for Patrol Deputies to respond to the scene at which time BCSO Deputies and our partners from the Palm Bay Police Department responded to assist!!

Since the incident occurred in the City of Palm Bay, their officers eagerly assumed the investigation and Amisial was subsequently transported to the Brevard County Jail on a "No Bond" status for Aggravated Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer.

Folks there are a lot of things that frustrate me in this world, but one thing that makes my blood boil is for someone to try and hurt one of my team!! These brave men and women are out here everyday working to keep our community safe and then some scumbag like this women, tries to permanently injure one of them!! Here is a simple rule...don't put your hands on one of my Deputies or team members unless you are willing to suffer the consequences!!

Thank you to our partner officers from Palm Bay PD for responding so quickly to help our Animal Enforcement Officer and for taking Amisial to jail, which is right where she belongs!! On a positive note, AEO Reuter is expected to make a full recovery and a check on the dog at the suspect's home, revealed that it was thankfully, not in harm's way!!
