CLAYTON, CIRCUIT JUDGE, SEVENTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT COURT OF FLORIDA, to proceed to the EIGHTEENTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT COURT OF FLORIDA to hear, conduct, try, and determine the above cause, which shall be presented to the judge as a temporary judge of said court, and thereafter to dispose of all matters considered by the judge in said cause, including issues of fees and costs arising out of said cause, but excluding other matters subsequently raised that are collateral to said cause. JUDGE CLAYTON, under and by virtue of the authority hereof, is hereby vested with all and singular the powers and prerogatives conferred by the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida upon a judge of the court to which the judge is hereby assigned.
