BEFORE ME, Jennifer Taylor [Circuit/County Court Judge in and for Brevard County, Florida,] personally came Detective Christen McClure #28, of the Cocoa Beach Police Department, who being duly sworn deposes and says: that Affiant has reason to believe and does believe that probable cause exists for the arrest of **ROBERT CARL CASON, a white male, approximately 5'09" in height, date of birth 03/27/1984, social security number [REDACTED] [REDACTED] brown hair, brown eyes whose last known address is 1218 Shady Pines Lane Titusville, Florida 32796** for a violation of the laws of the State of Florida, to wit: **Aggravated Battery with a deadly weapon x2 F.S.S. 784.045 and Battery x2 F.S.S. 784.03**

THE FACTS tending to establish the grounds for this application and the probable cause of Affiant believing that such facts exist are as follows:

On May 29, 2017 at approximately 2359 hours, officers responded to Cheaters located at 5450 N. Atlantic Avenue Brevard County Cocoa Beach Florida 32931 in reference to a battery with injuries. At approximately 1250 hours your affiant was contacted via phone and requested to respond to the City. Contact was made officers on scene located at Cheaters. On scene were several witnesses and victims who were interviewed and in substance advised the following:

All parties stated they took a taxi cab from Grills located at 505 Glen Cheek Drive Brevard County Cape Canaveral, Florida 32920 which is located in the port to Cheaters located in Cocoa Beach. All parties advised the taxi cab they took was a maroon minivan. Once they arrived at Cheaters, all parties exited the taxi cab to include the driver, ROBERT CARL CASON. ROBERT CARL CASON advised the parties a beer was spilt inside the taxi cab and the cost would be \$100.00 in order to clean it up.

ROBERT CARL CASON was advised he was paid for the fare and they were not going to give him any more money. ROBERT CARL CASON got upset and pushed Leslee Lefevre. Leslee's husband Pierre Lefevre intervened and told ROBERT CARL CASON they were not going to pay him any more money and that he needed to leave. ROBERT CARL CASON advised he was not leaving until someone gives him \$100.00.

ROBERT CARL CASON then swung his fist at Pierre missing him. In response Pierre swung his fist at ROBERT CARL CASON missing him. Seeing this action, David Hobson approached. ROBERT CARL



CASON grabbed David's neck and placed him in a choke hold. Michael Greene then approached and grabbed ROBERT CARL CASON and tried to put ROBERT CARL CASON in a choke hold to loosen ROBERT CARL CASON'S grip from David's neck.

At some point, ROBERT CARL CASON let go of David and broke free from Michael's grip. ROBERT CARL CASON then grabbed a glass beer bottle and strikes Pierre Lefevre in the head breaking it as it makes contact with Pierre's head. ROBERT CARL CASON then uses the broken beer bottle and sticks it into Pierre Lefevre's neck. ROBERT CARL CASON pulled the broken beer bottle in an upward motion slicing Pierre's left side neck up to the side of his head.


ROBERT CARL CASON then entered back into his vehicle and drove off using the roadway. Pierre and Michael went to follow the vehicle on foot using the sidewalk in an attempt to obtain the license plate number. Both Pierre and Michael were on the sidewalk when ROBERT CARL CASON decided to put the vehicle in reverse. ROBERT CARL CASON backed his vehicle striking Michael before fleeing the area. ROBERT CARL CASON backed up from the roadway into the grass median and over onto the sidewalk in order to strike Michael. During the incident Gerry Lefevre was able to obtain the license plate number from the taxi cab.

License plate number provided was 3874PC. A search through the Driver and Vehicle Information Database (DAVID) revealed the tag was assigned to ROBERT CARL CASON. The tag number is assigned to a 2005 Red in color Chrysler van and the registered owner is ROBERT CARL CASON. ROBERT CARL CASON matched the descriptors provided by the victims and witnesses as the person who was in physical control of the vehicle. Later in day, your affiant made contact with several of the victims and witnesses. All parties were shown photographic lineups. Six of the seven parties positively identified ROBERT CARL CASON in the photographic lineup.

Based on the above facts, statements and physical evidence provided, your Affiant has probable cause to believe and does believe that the above listed probable cause, all leads to the substantiation that defendant, **ROBERT CARL CASON**, has committed a violation of the laws of the State of Florida, to wit: **Aggravated Battery with a deadly weapon x2 F.S.S. 784.045 and Battery x2 F.S.S. 784.03.**

Your Affiant, Detective Christen McClure (hereinafter referred to as Your Affiant) is a sworn Law Enforcement Officer employed by the Cocoa Beach Police Department.

WHEREAS, your Affiant makes this affidavit and prays the issuance of an Arrest Warrant with authority to enter any premises to effect said arrest, in due form for the arrest of **ROBERT CARL CASON** for the violation of the laws of the State of Florida, to wit: **Aggravated Battery with a deadly weapon x2 F.S.S. 784.045 and Battery x2 F.S.S. 784.03.**
