6. Detailed Description of Misconduct: (Do not use generic terminology in this section such as conduct unbecoming, failed to meet agency standards, violation of agency operating procedures, etc. Detailed information describing the act of misconduct: Internal Investigation IA-2017-013 was sustained that Officer Matthew Miller violated department policies, to include honesty. On June 10, 2017, Officer Miller failed to issue property receipt for taking possession of items from a burglary scene and wrote in his report that the items were kept by the complainant. When it was found that the complainant had not kept the property, Officer Miller located the items and turned them into the property room. One of the items was a cellular phone. Officer Miller gave several conflicting stories to his supervisors as to where and how he found the missing property. Following the property being turned in by Officer Miller, it was discovered that one of the items, a cellular phone, was not the phone taken from scene. It belonged to one of Officer Miller's children and had not been active since September 2016. Officer Miller voluntarily resigned while IA-2017-013 was active.
