



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

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On the above date and time while performing my duties as the property officer I received a call from Unit 5 officer SRO. Harding and he stated that he had 6 releases and a TOT for Seminole County who was scheduled for a 1000 hrs. release. SRO. Harding stated that he would not bring the TOT inmate at this time and for me to call him when I was ready for him. When SRO. Harding arrived at the blue gate with the inmates for release, I instructed all of them to stand in the black box in the hallway. I then handed their property bags to them and instructed them to go into holding cell 9 and get dressed. I finished checking in inmates that were going to outside court and move them to the court holding cells. I then returned to the property office and checked the VCDC 214's against the active release list on JMS. While doing so I came across the VCDC 214 of I/M Redding, Michael 1051727 who was the scheduled for TOT to Seminole County. I immediately called Unit 5 and asked Ofc. Ramos if I/M Redding was physically on the unit, she stated that he was and I told her that I had his VCDC 214 in the property office. I then placed the VCDC 214 on the clip board so it didn't get mixed in with the others. I called booking and verified the releases with SRO Shields. I then one at a time called each inmate into the



office and verified their information, had them sign for their money, offer them a bus pass, and cut their wristbands off. When I was complete with the release process I escorted all the inmates to door 51 and handed them their plastic property bags as they stepped into the sallyport. I grabbed I/M Redding's plastic bag and called his name and immediately put it back in the box remembering that he was the TOT for Seminole County. Unknown to me I/M Redding was in the front of the line and walked into the release sallyport as soon as the door opened. When Sminole County arrived to pick up I/M Redding at approximately 1005 hrs I went to the property office to retrieve his property for release. I went into the property room to pull the property and noticed it was not on the shelf where it was supposed to be. I began searching the office and the property room to see if it was misplaced. When I was unable to locate it I asked Sgt Buckley to verify on Ocularis if he was able to see I/M Redding's bag at any time during the intake process. Sgt Buckley said it was the correct property number. I checked the garbage to see if I accidentally gave I/M Redding's clothing to another inmate I also checked holding cell 9 to see if it was left behind. I found the empty property bag in the garbage. I immediately notified Sgt Buckley and I called Unit 5 to verify again if I/M Redding was there, SRO Harding went into the block and I/M Redding was not there. Sgt Buckley and I looked on Ocularis to see if we could identify if I/M Redding was mistakingly released. I/M Redding was seen in the front of the line stepping into the door 51 sallyport. Sgt Buckley and I immediately notified Lt Shaw.



On 08/23/19 at approximately 1015 Sgt. Rivers was assigned and working property. He informed me that Inmate Redding, Michael 1051827 was going TOT to Seminole County and he could not locate his property which was assigned to hook #595. At this time I reviewed Ocularis when the inmate was booked in and confirmed that the inmates hook was in fact #595. I went to property and was starting a bag search when Sgt. Rivers came in with Inmate Redding's empty brown paper bag that his clothing should be in. At this time I asked Sgt. Rivers if the inmate was brought down earlier at which time he stated the inmate was still housed on Unit 5. I told him to call Unit 5 and verify they have the inmate. At this time I reviewed Ocularis and observed at 0645 Inmate Redding, M being walking out the door at the release vestibule. I then went back to when the inmates were brought down to ID/REC. I observed the inmate secured in a holding cell with other released and then brown paper bags with inmates personal clothes placed into the cell. The inmates were then pulled out of the cell and processed for release. Inmate Redding stood in the black box by the property office while all the other inmates were processed out. The inmates were then all escorted to the release vestibule. Ocularis showed Inmate Redding attempting to cover up his wristband and step into the sally port and he walked out of the release mantrap. I immediately notified Lt. Shaw of the situation. At this time I searched the VCBJ parking lot to verify that the inmate was not still in the area.

On the above date and time upon arriving to my assigned post on Unit 5 and receiving briefing from the previous shift, the VCDC 214 for the inmates to be released had already been pulled and placed on the desk in a pile. At approximately 0645 all inmates to be release were called and pulled out of the blocks. All inmates' wristbands were checked to their 214's and escorted to I/D and Rec by my partner. A few minutes later I received a call from Sgt. Rivers in Property asking if Inmate Redding, Michael 1051827 was taken down to I/D and Rec because had the TOTs paperwork (VCDC 214) and not the inmate was brought down to I/D and Rec. I advise him that my partner took down all the Inmates eligible for release but I couldn't say for sure. I also asked him if he needed Inmate Redding at that time and he stated that he did not need him at the moment, but would hold on to the 214 paperwork. I informed by partner, Sro. Harding, of the phone call to which he stated that he checked all wristbands to the 214's for release. At approximately 0800 hrs. I went home sick and am unaware of any further incidents that occurred.



On the above date and time while working my assigned post on Unit 5, I assisted with bringing down the scheduled releases to I/D and Rec. Upon arriving on the unit and receiving briefing from the previous shift, the VCDC 214 for the inmates to be released had already been pulled and placed on the desk in a pile. At approximately 0645 I gathered the VCDC 214s which were already pulled and notified the inmates via their 214's to pack up their belongings. I was made aware by the previous shift that there was a TOT scheduled, however I was not aware of his name and was not looking at JMS when I removed the inmates from the block. I however did check each inmates wristband and VCDC 214 as they exited the block and again when they were lined up in the Unit 5 hallway. I then escorted the inmates to the I/D gate and notified the Property Officer Sgt. Rivers that there were 6 inmates for release and 1 inmate for court. I then gave the VCDC 214s to the property officer and returned to Unit 5. When I returned to Unit 5 my partner, Ofc. Ramos stated that the Property Officer called and stated that I had brought down the TOT paperwork (VCDC 214) and not the inmate. I found this odd as I checked all the inmates wristbands along with their 214's and all were accounted for. I did however receive a call from Property Sgt. Rivers approximately an hour or two later asking if I/M Redding, Michael 1051827 was still on the unit. At that point I entered the C block sally port opened the cell door where I/M Redding was housed and called his name. I received no response and could clearly see that the bunk I/M Redding was housed in was unoccupied. I then notified Sgt. Rivers that I/M Redding was not on the unit. End of Report.
