IN THE NAME AND BY AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA, PHIL ARCHER, STATE ATTORNEY, THROUGH THE UNDERSIGNED DESIGNATED ASSISTANT STATE ATTORNEY, CHARGES THAT:

COUNT 1: IN THE COUNTY OF SEMINOLE, STATE OF FLORIDA, on or about December 29, 2021, [REDACTED] did knowingly obtain or use, or endeavor to obtain or use property, to wit: an Iphone and Keyfob, of the value of \$750.00 or more, but less than \$5,000.00, the property of [REDACTED] as owner or custodian, with the intent to, either temporarily or permanently, deprive said owner or custodian of a right to said property or a benefit therefrom, or to appropriate said property to the use of [REDACTED], or another person not entitled thereto, contrary to Sections 812.014(1), 812.014(2)(c)1, Florida Statutes,

COUNT 2: IN THE COUNTY OF SEMINOLE, STATE OF FLORIDA on or about December 29, 2021, [REDACTED] did unlawfully resist, obstruct or oppose Preston Meyer, an officer of the Winter Springs Police Department, while such officer was in the execution of legal process or in the lawful execution of a legal duty without offering or doing violence to the person of such officer, contrary to section 843.02, Florida Statutes,

COUNT 3: IN THE COUNTY OF SEMINOLE, STATE OF FLORIDA on or about December 29, 2021, [REDACTED] did enter a dwelling, located at [REDACTED] Florida, the property of [REDACTED], as owner or custodian, with the intent to commit an offense therein, and in the course of committing said burglary, [REDACTED] made an assault or battery upon [REDACTED] contrary to Sections 810.02(1)(b), 810.02(2)(a), 810.07, Florida Statutes,

COUNT 4: IN THE COUNTY OF SEMINOLE, STATE OF FLORIDA on or about December 29, 2021, [REDACTED] as a principal or active participant did engage in sexual activity with a person twelve years of age or older but less than 16 years of age,





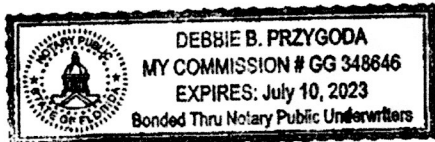
