3 On Monday, September 10, 2018, at 2310 hours Tyra Harley(R1) [REDACTED] reported a family disturbance at [REDACTED], New

4 Smyrna Beach. Harley advised Central Communications of the following; the disturbance was verbal between her sister; Chanel Barrow(V1) and

5 her estranged husband; Andre Isaac(D1). Harley advised Isaac(D1) had previously locked items belonging to Barrow in a vehicle and was refusing

6 to give them to his estranged wife. Harley advised both parties had separated and she would met deputies down the street away from the

7 residence. While deputies were enroute to the residence Isaac(D1) [REDACTED] report Harley was at his residence refusing to leave and

8 requested deputies respond.

9

10 At 2326 hours Deputy Becker responded to [REDACTED], New Smyrna Beach and made contact with Isaac(D1). Isaac(D1) advised of the



NARRATIVE / CONTINUATION

11 following; he recently filed for divorce from Barrow and the two were no longer residing together. Barrow came to the residence and was texting on
 12 her cell phone. A verbal argument ensued because Barrow would not show Isaac(D1) the phone to prove she was texting her mother. Barrow left
 13 the residence in her vehicle and returned several minutes later to retrieve her children. Isaac(D1) along with his parents asked Barrow for his cell
 14 phone and she refused to return it. Barrow told Isaac(D1) his phone was in her vehicle underneath a front seat. Isaac(D1) opened a vehicle door
 15 and began searching for his cell phone. Barrow in a fit of rage jumped onto Isaac's(D1) back and bit him on the right side of his upper back. To get
 16 Barrow off of him, Isaac(D1) stood up and pressed Barrow against the side of her vehicle. Once free Isaac(D1) got into his vehicle and left the
 17 area. Isaac(D1) advised when he returned home he parked his vehicle near a telephone pole on his parents property. Isaac(D1) was walking in
 18 the street towards the driveway as a small passenger car driven by Harley came down the street at a high rate of speed. Isaac(D1) advised the
 19 vehicle came towards him and he had to jump out of the way to avoid being ran over. Isaac(D1) provided a written statement and stated he did not
 20 wish to pursue criminal charges against Barrow or her sister.
 21
 22 Deputy Becker observed an impression on the upper right side of Isaac's(D1) back that was consistent with a bite mark. Deputy Becker took 2
 23 photographs of the impression and 1 photograph of Isaac(D1) as evidence.
 24
 25 Deputy Becker left the residence and responded to the intersection of Warren Avenue and Washington Street, New Smyrna Beach and made
 26 contact with Harley. Harley advised she was not exactly sure what was going on between her sister and Isaac(D1). Harley advised she came to
 27 the residence to bring her sister a pair of shoes and when she arrived observed Barrow exit a wooded area with two of her children. Harley
 28 advised she loaded up the children in her vehicle [REDACTED]. Barrow advised she was not sure where her sister went but, believed she left
 29 the area traveling towards South Daytona in her vehicle.
 30
 31 Deputy Becker provided Harley with a business card and advised her that he needed to speak with Barrow about the incident. Deputy Becker
 32 responded back to Isaac's(D1) residence for further investigation. Contact was made with Anthony Isaac(W1) and Karessa Williams(W2).
 33
 34 Isaac(W1) advised of the following; he was awoken to a loud argument between his son; Isaac(D1) and Barrow over a cell phone. Barrow left
 35 the residence on foot as Isaac(D1) checked the car for his cell phone. Harley arrived looking for her sister and was told Barrow had left. Harley left
 36 the residence at a high rate of speed nearly hitting Isaac(D1). Isaac(W1) advised during the altercation Barrow bit his son on the back. Isaac(W1)
 37 provided a written statement.
 38
 39 Williams advised she was inside her residence when she heard a horn honking. Williams looked outside and observed an unknown vehicle in
 40 her yard and thought it was a traffic crash. Williams heard arguing as she went outside and observed a small dark colored car leaving the area.
 41 The vehicle returned at a high rate of speed and Isaac(D1) had to walk fast to avoid getting hit by the car. Williams provided a written statement.
 42
 43 Believing Barrow was the primary aggressor Deputy Becker provided Isaac(D1) with a domestic abuse pamphlet (which he signed for) and
 44 explained what his legal rights regarding domestic violence were. Isaac(D1) advised he did not want Barrow arrested. While Deputy Becker was
 45 onscene conducting an investigation Isaac(D1) made several commits about how his brother was previous arrested for domestic battery when a
 46 female lied to law enforcement and he was worried about being arrested.
 47
 48 Deputy Becker had Deputy Carelli respond to 1769 S Clyde Morris Blvd unit 103, Daytona Beach and make contact with Barrow regarding the
 49 incident (see Deputy Carelli's supplement for details). After speaking with Deputy Carelli it was determined Isaac(D1) was the primary aggressor.
 50 Deputies re-contacted Isaac(D1) at his residence and placed him under arrest for simple battery (domestic violence). Isaac(D1) was transported to
 51 the Volusia County Branch Jail. The BWC recording and digital photographs were uploaded to the VCSO Digital Crime Scene Database.

1 BWC RECORDING.

 3 On Monday, September 10, 2018, at 2310 hours Tyra Harley(R1) reported a family disturbance at New
 4 Smyrna Beach. Harley advised Central Communications of the following; the disturbance was verbal between her sister; Chanel Barrow(V1) and her
 5 estranged husband; Andre Isaac(D1). Harley advised Isaac(D1) had previously locked items belonging to Barrow in a vehicle and was refusing to
 6 give them to his estranged wife. Harley advised both parties had separated and she would met deputies down the street away from the residence.
 7 While deputies were enroute to the residence Isaac(D1) report Harley was at his residence refusing to leave and requested deputies
 8 respond.
 9
 10 At 2326 hours Deputy Becker responded to New Smyrna Beach and made contact with Isaac(D1). Isaac(D1) advised of the
 11 following; he recently filed for divorce from Barrow and the two were no longer residing together. Barrow came to the residence and was texting on
 12 her cell phone. A verbal argument ensued because Barrow would not show Isaac(D1) the phone to prove she was texting her mother. Barrow left the
 13 residence in her vehicle and returned several minutes later to retrieve her children. Isaac(D1) along with his parents asked Barrow for his cell phone
 14 and she refused to return it. Barrow told Isaac(D1) his phone was in her vehicle underneath a front seat. Isaac(D1) opened a vehicle door and began
 15 searching for his cell phone. Barrow in a fit of rage jumped onto Isaac's(D1) back and bit him on the right side of his upper back. To get Barrow off of

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16 him, Isaac(D1) stood up and pressed Barrow against the side of her vehicle. Once free Isaac(D1) got into his vehicle and left the area. Isaac(D1)
 17 advised when he returned home he parked his vehicle near a telephone pole on his parents property. Isaac(D1) was walking in the street towards the
 18 driveway as a small passenger car driven by Harley came down the street at a high rate of speed. Isaac(D1) advised the vehicle came towards him
 19 and he had to jump out of the way to avoid being ran over. Isaac(D1) provided a written statement and stated he did not wish to pursue criminal
 20 charges against Barrow or her sister.
 21

22 Deputy Becker observed an impression on the upper right side of Isaac's(D1) back that was consistent with a bite mark. Deputy Becker took 2
 23 photographs of the impression and 1 photograph of Isaac(D1) as evidence.
 24

25 Deputy Becker left the residence and responded to the intersection of Warren Avenue and Washington Street, New Smyrna Beach and made
 26 contact with Harley. Harley advised she was not exactly sure what was going on between her sister and Isaac(D1). Harley advised she came to the
 27 residence to bring her sister a pair of shoes and when she arrived observed Barrow exit a wooded area with two of her children. Harley advised she
 28 loaded up the children in her vehicle [REDACTED]. Barrow advised she was not sure where her sister went but, believed she left the area traveling
 29 towards South Daytona in her vehicle.
 30

31 Deputy Becker provided Harley with a business card and advised her that he needed to speak with Barrow about the incident. Deputy Becker
 32 responded back to Isaac's(D1) residence for further investigation. Contact was made with Anthony Isaac(W1) and Karessa Williams(W2).
 33

34 Isaac(W1) advised of the following; he was awoken to a loud argument between his son; Isaac(D1) and Barrow over a cell phone. Barrow left the
 35 residence on foot as Isaac(D1) checked the car for his cell phone. Harley arrived looking for her sister and was told Barrow had left. Harley left the
 36 residence at a high rate of speed nearly hitting Isaac(D1). Isaac(W1) advised during the altercation Barrow bit his son on the back. Isaac(W1)
 37 provided a written statement.
 38

39 Williams advised she was inside her residence when she heard a horn honking. Williams looked outside and observed an unknown vehicle in her
 40 yard and thought it was a traffic crash. Williams heard arguing as she went outside and observed a small dark colored car leaving the area. The
 41 vehicle returned at a high rate of speed and Isaac(D1) had to walk fast to avoid getting hit by the car. Williams provided a written statement.
 42

43 Believing Barrow was the primary aggressor Deputy Becker provided Isaac(D1) with a domestic abuse pamphlet (which he signed for) and
 44 explained what his legal rights regarding domestic violence were. Isaac(D1) advised he did not want Barrow arrested. While Deputy Becker was
 45 onscene conducting an investigation Isaac(D1) made several commits about how his brother was previous arrested for domestic battery when a
 46 female lied to law enforcement and he was worried about being arrested.
 47

48 Deputy Becker had Deputy Carelli respond to 1769 S Clyde Morris Blvd unit 103, Daytona Beach and make contact with Barrow regarding the
 49 incident. Deputy Carelli made contact with Chanel Barrows (V1) who advised she went to [REDACTED] NSB to meet with Andre Isaac (D1). Isaac
 50 (D1) accused Barrows of cheating when he saw her on her phone and an argument ensued. While the argument was on going, Barrows grabbed her
 51 keys and stated she was leaving. Upon attempting to leave the residence, Isaac (D1) bear hugged Barrows from behind in attempt to get the keys
 52 from her. Barrows was able to break free of Isaac (D1), but Isaac (D1) then grabbed the back of Barrows' neck causing two lacerations on her neck.
 53 Deputy Carelli observed two small lacerations on her neck with freshly broke skin which would be consistent with her statement. Barrows stated she
 54 broke away again, got in her vehicle and left. After Barrows left the residence, Issac (D1) texted her telling her to get the kids from his house. Barrows
 55 returned to the house to retrieve her kids, when another argument ensued about infidelities. Barrows attempted to get the kids into the vehicle and
 56 leave, but Isaac (D1) would not let her leave. Barrows managed to get into the vehicle and attempt to drive away, but Isaac (D1) proceeded to grab
 57 on the steering wheel, causing the vehicle to almost crash in attempt to get the keys. Eventually Isaac (D1) was able to overpower Barrows and grab
 58 her keys (which powered off Barrows' push to start vehicle). Once the vehicle was stopped, Isaac (D1) proceeded to grab items from her bags and
 59 throw them out of her vehicle. Barrows attempted to get Isaac (D1) to stop, but could not. Barrows stated while they were fighting, Isaac's (D1) elbow
 60 struck her son Andre Isaac (O1). After continual efforts to stop Isaac (D1), Barrows grabbed Isaac (D1) and bit him on his right side in an attempt to
 61 provide safety for her and her children. Once bit, Isaac (D1) threw Barrows to the ground, causing her to slam her head against the door of the car,
 62 and then he proceeded to throw items out of the vehicle again. While he was throwing items out of the car, Barrows grabbed her kids and ran into the
 63 woods to call her sister to pick them up. Deputy Carelli observed Barrows' sweat pants to be muddy and ripped, which would be consistent with her
 64 statement of being thrown to the ground.
 65

66 Barrows' daughter, Amarie Grice (W3) was present at the scene of questioning and witnessed the second half of the incident. Grice's (W3) statement

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67 was consistent with her mother's. Both Grice (W3) and Barrows completed sworn written statements. Deputy Carelli provided Barrows with a
 68 domestic violence pamphlet, which she signed for receiving.
 69
 70 After speaking with Deputy Carelli it was determined Isaac(D1) was the primary aggressor. Deputies re-contacted Isaac(D1) at his residence and
 71 placed him under arrest for simple battery (domestic violence). Isaac(D1) was transported to the Volusia County Branch Jail. The BWC recording and
 72 digital photographs were uploaded to the VCSO Digital Crime Scene Database.

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
