We question whether the City of Wilton Manors acted appropriately, and within Florida law regarding the disposition of their last allegations against Mr. Perez.

Apparently, Mr. Perez was allowed to resign, in lieu of facing an investigation regarding illegal compensation within the WMPD. These allegations have the possibility of being violations of agency policies, as well as violations of Florida and federal laws.

It would appear via media accounts, that the City of Wilton Manors and Mr. Perez came to a separation agreement. We believe that regardless of former Chief Perez's decision to retire, and regardless of any separation agreement that the City of Wilton Manors and Mr. Perez entered into, the allegations lodged by the city should have been investigated as per Florida Statutes 943.1395(5)
