Attached you will find a PDF copy of the FDLE Office of Executive Investigations review of allegations, that Police Chief Arcieri possibly violated criminal statutes attached to him obtaining his Associate degree from a local community college.

Although, it is noted that the Office of Executive Investigations closed their review, due to the local State Attorney's opinion that the matter would not be prosecuted, CJSTC has the authority to process these allegations, whether criminally prosecuted or not.
