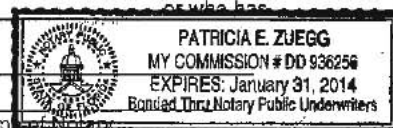

Attached you will find documentation related to the arrest and subsequent suspension from duty of Probationary Officer Gary Ward.

Based upon the findings of a criminal investigation conducted by members of the Daytona Beach Police Department, supported by the sworn statement of Officer Ward's [REDACTED] probable cause has been established that Ward committed an act of domestic violence.

Pursuant to mandatory protocol, I have directed that all information relative to Officer Ward's arrest be forwarded to the Florida Department of Law Enforcement – Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission for disciplinary review.

His conduct, as detailed in the arrest affidavit, is contrary to this department's Code of Honor, as well as our rules, regulations, and general orders.

It is my professional recommendation that Officer Ward's employment with this agency be terminated immediately.

At approximately 1:30am, Sergeant Michael Coomans contacted me reference an ongoing domestic violence incident involving Officer Gary Ward. According to Sergeant Coomans, at approximately 12:48am, the Daytona Beach Police Department responded to Ward's home located at [REDACTED]

Sergeant Coomans was briefed about the incident from Sergeant McBride -- Daytona Beach Police Department on-shift supervisor. According to Sergeant McBride, Wards' [REDACTED] contacted the police after Ward broke the passenger side window of their vehicle and became extremely aggressive. The two were arguing over an incident that happened earlier in the day. [REDACTED] added that Ward was intoxicated and had been drinking at the 509 Club located on Seabreeze Blvd. [REDACTED] explained that Ward had thrown several things at her and threatened to "kill her" if she contacted the police.

I met with Sergeant McBride and he provided the charging affidavit and a sworn statement. Sergeant Coomans collected Wards' departmental issued firearm and placed it in a secure compartment at the police department. Captain Aldrich changed all the door codes. As of now, [REDACTED] is no longer living at the apartment until Ward is apprehended.

I have attached Sergeant Coomans memo, the charging affidavit with [REDACTED] written statement. I have also sent an email to the supervisors explaining that Officer Ward is no longer permitted to be in the building. In fact, Sergeant McBride asked that we detain Ward if he showed up at the police department. (He is not due to work until Friday night.) Sergeant McBride also explained that Officer McClain obtained an audio statement of [REDACTED] but it was not available until Captain Opunick arrived.

At approximately 4:15am, Ward was arrested at his apartment complex without incident. Captain Aldrich and I served him with a notice of suspension.

On 10-10-13 at 01:41 hours, I received a call from Sergeant McBride of the Daytona Beach Police Department reference a domestic disturbance involving Gary Ward an off-duty officer from this agency. Sergeant McBride advised Mr. Ward and his [REDACTED] were involved in an argument inside their apartment at [REDACTED]. During this time, Mr. Ward threw furniture around the apartment. Said argument then continued into the parking lot; at which time Mr. Ward busted the windshield of their blue 2005 Dodge Stratus. It is unknown at this time whether said vehicle was occupied or not when the windshield was busted. Mr. Ward then left the scene; at which time [REDACTED] called the police. As a result of the incident, Sergeant McBride stated his officer would be completing an affidavit against Mr. Ward for battery simple domestic violence. Sergeant McBride further stated if contact was made with Mr. Ward he would be arrested. Mr. Ward's whereabouts are currently unknown. Contact was made with Captain Miller who advised me to retrieve Mr. Ward's service weapon along with a copy of the affidavit. I recovered said weapon from Officer Steven Catalano and placed it evidence for safekeeping. During this time, Officer Catalano stated Mr. Ward made the following statement to [REDACTED] prior to leaving the scene: "If you call the police, I will kill you!"




