At any time, the Court may cancel or modify any of the conditions of your probation; or may extend the period of probation as authorized by law; or may discharge you from further supervision. If you violate any conditions of your probation, you may be arrested and the Court may revoke your probation and impose any sentence that it might have imposed before you were placed on probation.

Standard Conditions of Probation

- A. Personally report to your probation officer at least once per month during the period of your probation, unless ordered differently by the Court.
- B. Allow your probation officer to visit you at your residence, place of employment, or elsewhere. Obey all instructions given to you by your probation officer and answer all questions asked of you truthfully.
- C. Immediately inform your probation officer if you change your residence or place of employment
- D. Do not violate any federal, state, or local laws. Your probation may be revoked for violating the law, even if not convicted.
- E. Do not use alcoholic beverages to excess, nor visit places where intoxicants, drugs or other dangerous substances are unlawfully sold, dispensed, or used. Do not possess or use illegal substances.
- F. Work diligently at a lawful occupation and support yourself and dependents to the best of your ability.
- G. Pay \$45.00 per month for the cost of your supervision to your probation provider, unless waived by the Court or probation provider.
- H. Pay all court costs, fines, fees and restitution ordered by the Court. Also pay all costs associated with probationary programs, courses, evaluations and treatment as required.
- I. Complete all conditions of your probation no later than 45 days prior to the end of your probationary term, unless ordered differently by the Court.
