Dear Mr. Jacobs and Mr. Archer:

VolusiaExposed.Com is preparing for publication - later today - a short initial article regarding the recent BCSO deputy involved shooting death of Mr. Howard.

VolusiaExposed.Com has received evidence (recording of official BCSO radio traffic) that suggests that BCSO Deputy Yousef Hafza immediately left the scene of the shooting - failing to secure the scene - and rendering medical assistance to Mr. Howard.

Mr. Jacobs - will you office confirm that the shooting of Mr. Howard was indeed a "shoot and scoot" - and provide us with the rationale for Deputy Hafza's abandonment of the shooting scene?

Mr. Jacobs - the recent BCSO press release reflected Mr. Howard's age at 22 years - however, official court records appear to indicate his DOB as 10-23-1990 - making him 25 years of age. Please clarify - is the homicide victim the very same person arrested in the below listed criminal court case?

Mr. Archer - according to court records (05-2015-CF-051096) - Mr. Howard was arrested in December 2015 under multiple counts of child porn with intent to promote the sexual performance of a child. These same

court records also seem to reflect that approximately a month after his arrest - that Mr. Howard was released from custody under a ROR status. Lastly - the court records seem to indicate that your office abandoned the prosecution of Mr. Howard in April of this year.

Mr. Archer - please either correct our understanding of the court records AND / OR provide us with your office's rationale for abandoning this prosecution. Your office - will of course - appreciate our desire to seek the truth in every detail.

Our pending article will question whether there is a connection between Mr. Howard's December 2015 arrest and his homicide.

Gentlemen - any clarity your offices can bring to our questions and concerns will be greatly appreciated.
