NARRATIVE

The undersigned certifies and swears that there is probable cause to believe the above named defendant, on the 29 day of OCTOBER, 2011, at approximately 05:30 a.m. at 9 th 13 Aspen Street, Daytona Beach, Florida within VOLUSIA County, violated the law and did then and there:

On the morning of October 29, 2011 at approximately 05:36 hrs, Volusia County Sheriff's Office received a call for shots fired at 13 Aspen Street, Daytona Beach, Florida 32124. Deputies responded to the area and located the body of Brian R. Leverett (DOB: 02/09/70) in the carport of that residence. Mr. Leverett was found to be deceased, as a result of multiple gunshot wounds. Justin N. Riley (DOB: 11/29/81) was found inside the residence, with a severe laceration to the arm.

Neighbors reported that an argument had occurred in the front yard of 9 Aspen Street, just prior to the shooting. At least two suspects were observed re-entering 9 Aspen Street after the incident. Another individual (Scott Searles) was observed leaving the scene in a pick-up truck and subsequently stopped by deputies.

Upon interview, Mr. Searles reported that Ray & Wayne Greenlaw had been engaged in an argument with the above-named victims at 9

Aspen Street. After the two victims were expelled from the home by the Greenlaws. Wayne Greenlaw armed himself with a .223 rifle and provided Ray Greenlaw a 9mm handgun. Scott Searles reported that Wayne Greenlaw said that he would "kill" the victims, as a result of the argument that had occurred. Ray Greenlaw was present at the time of the statement and accepted the firearm from his brother, when the statement was made.


Deputies then made contact with Ray and Wayne Greenlaw, at 9 Aspen Street. Both individuals were detained for questioning and interviewed at the Volusia County Sheriff's Office Operations Center.

The pertinent portions of Ray Greenlaw's statement are as follows:

Ray Greenlaw reported that an argument occurred between his brother, the two victims, and himself inside the residence at 9 Aspen Street. At some point, the victims were expelled from the residence and became hostile. Ray Greenlaw admitted that he locked the individuals out of the home and retrieved a machete. When he opened the door a few minutes later, the victims were in the yard and the argument continued. In an effort to make them leave, he swung the machete and struck Mr. Riley in the arm (causing the laceration). He then closed the door and both victims left the premises. Inside, Wayne and Ray Greenlaw had a conversation and armed themselves with firearms. Wayne Greenlaw gave his brother Ray Greenlaw a 9 mm handgun and kept a .223 rifle for himself. According to Ray Greenlaw, both defendants exited the residence and walked in the direction of 13 Aspen Street. At that location, they encountered Mr. Leverett and both began to discharge their weapons in the direction of the victim. Mr. Leverett sought refuge in the carport of 13 Aspen Street and both defendants fired into the carport in an effort to shoot Mr. Leverett. Though Ray Greenlaw reported a general fear of the victims, he was unable to state the basis for those feelings. He was unaware of the location of the victims, after they left his home. He had only met the victims that night, had no knowledge of the victims' background or character, and did not know whether the victims were armed during this encounter. Ray Greenlaw stated that neither victim made a threat of imminent harm to either defendant. Ray Greenlaw further stated that he remained angry with both of the victims as a result of the argument.

The pertinent portions of Wayne Greenlaw's statement are as follows:

Wayne Greenlaw reported that an argument had occurred within the residence of 9 Aspen Street. He stated that the victims appeared at the residence for the purpose of selling illegal narcotics. He further stated that he and his brother were not interested in purchasing the narcotics, which resulted in an argument among the parties. During the argument, Wayne Greenlaw retrieved a firearm from



another room in the house. When Wayne Greenlaw returned, the victims had already exited the residence. Wayne Greenlaw was unaware of any incident involving a machete and his brother. Wayne Greenlaw, who was armed with a .223 rifle stated that he provided a 9 mm handgun to his brother and the two exited the residence in search of the victims. Wayne Greenlaw fired two warning shots into the air and he and his brother proceeded toward 13 Aspen Street. He reported that he saw one of the victims and fired his weapon. Though he denies firing a weapon in the direction of the house / carport, the defendant admits that he fired his weapon in the direction of the victim, who came to rest in the carport. Wayne Greenlaw stated that he went after the victims because he was afraid that the victims might return to the residence at 9 Aspen Street. Wayne Greenlaw also admits that he fired approximately 15 rounds at the victim. The 9 mm was loaded with approximately the same number of rounds. Though Wayne Greenlaw reported a general fear of the victims, he was unable to state the basis for those feelings. He was unaware of the location of the victims, after they left his home. He had only met the victims that night, had no knowledge of the victims' background or character, and did not know whether the victims were armed during this encounter. Wayne Greenlaw stated that neither victim made a threat of imminent harm to either defendant. Wayne Greenlaw further stated that he remained angry with both of the victims as a result of the argument.

The evidence at the scene demonstrates that the defendants stood shoulder-to-shoulder in the street and fired in the direction of 13 Aspen Street. Numerous rounds of spent 9 mm ammunition and .223 ammunition were located on the street near the residence. Approximately 26-28 bullets struck the interior portion of the carport at 13 Aspen street. Crime scene investigators stated that both .223 rounds and 9 rounds were recovered from the interior portion of the carport, in close proximity to the victim. At the time of the shooting, 13 Aspen Street was occupied by multiple persons to include David A. Royal (DOB: 08/23/82) and his family.

A large amount of blood was also found in the street in front of 9 Aspen Street and followed the path that Riley took to get help from the residence at 13 Aspen Street. There was no blood evidence found on the property of 9 Aspen Street. Ballistic evidence and weapons used in the incident were located at the places that both Wayne and Ray Greenlaw stated they would be found.

Investigation revealed that after Riley and Leverett fled 9 Aspen Street, Leverett retrieved his own firearm and proceeded toward 13 Aspen Street. Both defendants stated that they were unward that Leverett had a firearm in his possession. Furthermore, both defendants stated that the victim did not return fire and did not discharge a weapon. Though several bullets struck Mr. Leverett, both defendants stated that they could not clearly see Leverett because it was still dark outside and there was no ambient light. Both defendants stated that they were not able to identify the Leverett (as one of the individuals in the argument) at the time they discharged their weapons.

It should be noted that Ray Greenlaw is a convicted felon.

Wayne Greenlaw further stated that he remained angry with both of the victims as a result of the argument.
