As you may be aware - VolusiaExposed.Com has published a series of articles covering the arrest and criminal prosecution of Dana Delaney Loyd. VolusiaExposed.Com anticipates publishing yet another article in our investigative series - that will question whether Judge Lemonidis' recently available private website biased Mrs. Loyd's ability to receive a fair trial.

Prior to assuming her judicial duties in January 2015 - Judge Lemonidis was a private criminal defense attorney out of Melbourne, Florida. Her law office operated the website of <http://www.not-guilty.pro>.

Recently (within the last few days) this website has been removed from the Internet.

Our pending article will present "screen shots" of Judge Lemonidis' website - in which she discusses the crime of engaging in sex with minors. (see attached PDF document)

Within her "sex with minors" web page - Judge Lemonidis stated - "The sad FACT is that many child victims have been coached (especially if the case arises in the middle of a divorce, as many do). In defending these cases, I use cutting-edge psychological research on child interview techniques and on the unreliability of child witnesses."

The nexus of Loyd's arrest and prosecution - was her allegation that a local father was engaging his minor daughter in a sexual relationship.

VolusiaExposed.Com anticipates questioning whether prospective jurors

could have reviewed Judge Lemonidis' web comments - prior to - or as they served on the Loyd jury. Exploring our concern - whether some of these jurors factored in Judge Lemonidis' self-professed cutting edge skills of being able to root out false sex allegations - in coming to their guilty verdict against Loyd.
