ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANT'S UNOPPOSED MOTION TO SET BOND


THIS CAUSE having come on to be considered on this the 29th day of August, 2016, upon the defendant's Unopposed Motion to set Bond, it is hereby

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Motion is **GRANTED**. Bond is set as follows: Count I: \$30,000. Count II: \$30,000. Conditions of bond are:

- Defendant must be fitted with, and continue to be monitored by, a GPS Unit. Installation of the Unit must occur prior to, or simultaneously with, the Defendant's release on bond.
- Defendant must forfeit his passport to the safe keeping of the Clerk of the Court in and for Brevard County. This forfeiture must occur prior to the Defendant's release on bond.
- Defendant may not own, possess, or have within any vehicles in which he is riding or to which he has access, or residences in which he resides or visits, any firearms or firearm ammunition.
- Defendant may not return to Brevard County, Florida, for any purpose, other than mandatory court appearances at the Brevard County Courthouse located at 2825 Judge Fran Jamieson Way, Viera, Florida. Travel to and from said courthouse must be via direct means, with no stops, other than those caused by traffic or traffic control devices, at locations during the ingress to, or egress from, said courthouse.
- Defendant must have no contact with either the surviving victim, Jose Montanez, nor the family of the deceased victim, Clarence Howard. This prohibition includes contact that is direct, indirect, telephonic, written, electronic,

via a third party, or as sent through computer, wire, or related means.


