



1 WHEREUPON:

2 DONNA LAVALLEE,

3 a witness, having first been duly sworn, was examined and
4 testified as follows:

5 DIRECT EXAMINATION

6 BY MR. NELSON:

7 Q Would you state your full name for the record,
8 please?

9 A Donna Lavallee.

10 Q Ms. Lavallee, my name is Steve Nelson. I am an
11 Assistant State Attorney and I have been assigned to
12 investigate certain matters concerning issues raised with
13 the New Smyrna Beach City Commission, some alleged criminal
14 activity.

15 As a part of that there is one matter that
16 involves yourself that since it involves an allegation of a
17 criminal nature and you are the person it is directed
18 against, I am going to advise you of your Constitutional
19 Rights to make sure you are knowingly and freely giving this
20 statement to us today, okay?

21 A Okay.

22 Q You have a right to remain silent. Anything that
23 you say will be used against you. You have the right to
24 talk to an attorney and have him with you now or at any time
25 during the questioning. If you can't afford an attorney one

1 would be appointed for you. If at any time you want to stop
2 talking or have an attorney present, all questioning will be
3 stopped.

4 Do you understand these rights?

5 A Yes, I do.

6 Q Understanding those rights, do you waive those
7 rights and are you willing to talk to me at this time?

8 A Yes, sir.

9 Q How do you spell your last name?

10 A L-a-v-a-l-l-e-e.

11 Q What is your current position with the New Smyrna
12 Beach Police Department?

13 A I am the Department Training Officer.

14 Q What is your rank?

15 A That's it. I was promoted from sergeant to this.
16 It's kind of in-between sergeant and lieutenant.

17 Q Mrs. Lavallee, there has been an allegation that
18 the GED that was obtained in your name was obtained by
19 another person and was used by you improperly in getting
20 your qualifications to be a law enforcement officer. As a
21 part of this application I believe with the New Smyrna Beach
22 Police Department, you filed an affidavit of applicant,
23 which stated under a Notary Seal that you were a high school
24 graduate or it's equivalent.

25 What equivalency did you have of a high school

1 graduation?

2 A A GED.

3 Q There is a diploma that was issued -- that
4 apparently was issued and the numbers on it indicate a
5 331046 and it was dated July 18th, 1982 and then marked out
6 or -- not marked out but underneath it a handwritten date of
7 '84.

8 Was that a diploma issued to you?

9 A That I don't -- I have a diploma, yes. I don't
10 know if this is it.

11 Q That purports to be in the name of Donna Jean Hand
12 and I believe that is a copy of the diploma furnished to
13 your department for purposes of your examination?

14 A Yes, sir.

15 I need to find my original diploma. It's at my
16 house. I will be more than happy to bring it in.

17 I don't know anything about the '82. I know what
18 you are talking about on that one; I can see it plainly.

19 I feel that someone is doing something. There is
20 a lot of turmoil around the Police Department.

21 I don't know anything about that and I feel I am
22 being set up.

23 Q Do you really?

24 A Yes, I do.

25 Q Well, it's obvious, I think, from checking your

1 records that you did take -- I believe in the name of Donna
2 Jean Hand you took the GED in Daytona Beach; is that
3 correct?

4 A Yes, I did and I showed my driver's license.

5 Q Do you recall the date that you took that?

6 A To be honest with you, I don't know the date.

7 Q Whatever their records reflect, would that be it?

8 A Yes.

9 Q Did you only take it once as opposed to more than
10 once?

11 A I took it twice.

12 Q Do you know -- obviously if you took it twice you
13 weren't successful the first time?

14 A That's correct.

15 I got another GED book and I studied and re-took
16 the test.

17 Q Did you go to any GED classes to take it the
18 second time?

19 A No, sir.

20 Q How long a time transpired between the time that
21 you first took it and were unsuccessful and you took it the
22 second time; do you recall?

23 A No, sir.

24 Q I think your date of completion was somewhere in
25 '84 that you passed the test; is that --

1 A Yes, this is signed in '85 and that is correct.
2 January 30th of '85, I had successfully completed
3 the GED.

4 Q The test that you took, where did you take it?

5 A Daytona, DBCC.

6 Q Did you travel to Daytona yourself?

7 A Yes, sir, I had a -- what car did I have?

8 Q Was it in Daytona Beach?

9 A Yes, sir.

10 Q Was it the college on Volusia Avenue?

11 A Yes, sir.

12 I can't remember the room numbers or anything.



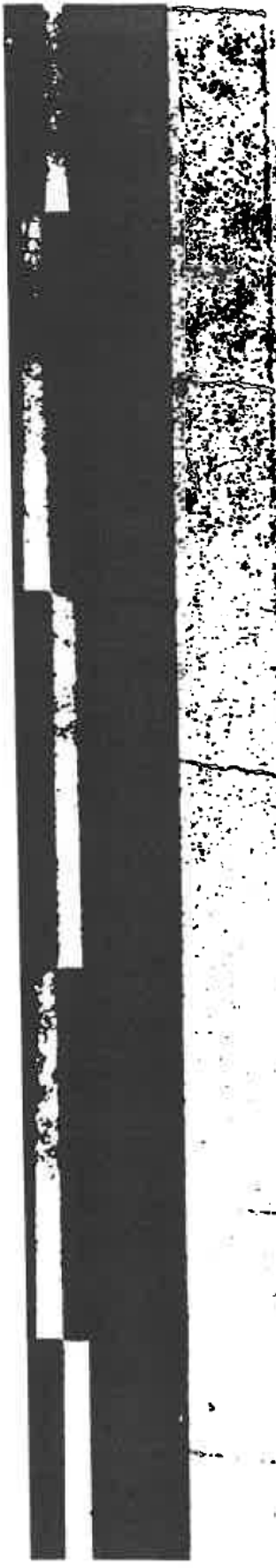

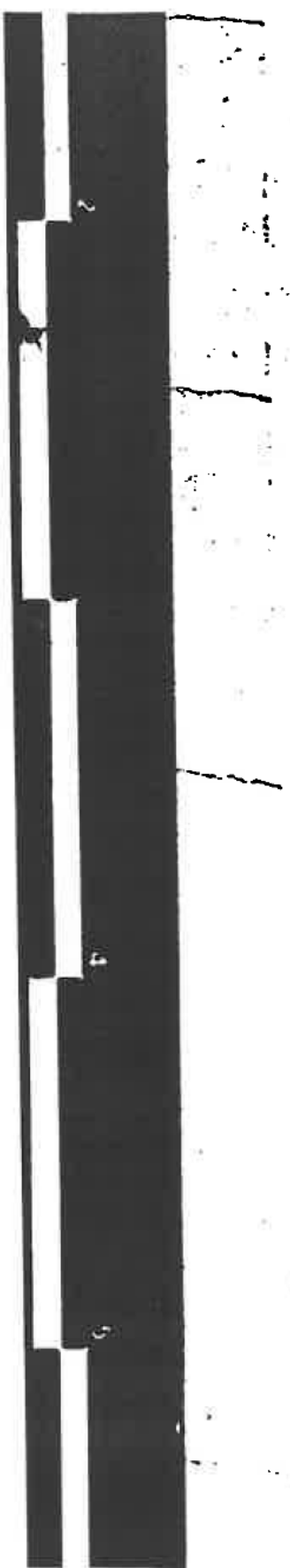
