After arriving at the Port Orange Police Department, I gathered basic information with regard to the incident.

	5	On September 15, 2015 at approximately 2234 hours, Port Orange Patrol Officer Edward Valez conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle being operated by Randy Wilson. Shortly after the stop, Officer Edward Valez turned the investigation over to Port Orange Patrol Officers Maira Ragon and Ashley Kortwright to assist with the training of Officer Ashley Kortwright. At the conclusion of their investigation, Officers Maira Ragon and Ashley Kortwright placed Randy Wilson under arrest for "Driving Under the Influence." This arrest occurred at approximately 2301 hours. Randy Wilson was taken into custody without incident and was transported to the Port Orange Police Department for processing.

NARRATIVE / CONTINUATION

11 Randy Wilson had displayed several signs of impairment during the DUI investigation. As a result, it was requested of Randy Wilson to submit to

12 a breath test. Randy Wilson agreed to submit to this test. The results of Randy Wilson's breath tests were .000 g/210L of breath. It was at this

13 point, it was requested of Randy Wilson to provide a urine sample in compliance with a potential Drug Recognition Expert Evaluation. Randy

14 Wilson refused to participate in this evaluation or to provide a urine sample. Randy Wilson was then placed into cell number 4 of the Holding

15 Facility at the Port Orange Police Department.

17 After Randy Wilson had been in the cell for approximately one hour and forty minutes, Randy Wilson appeared to suffer an unknown medical

18 problem. This medical problem resulted in Randy Wilson becoming unresponsive. Officers Maira Ragon and Ashley Kortwright began first aid

19 and CPR efforts on Randy Wilson. Additionally, Officer Maira Ragon called for assistance. Port Orange Patrol Sergeant Warren Carman,

20 Lieutenant Roxanne Morrow, and Officer Sylvio Portillo responded to the Holding Facility and assisted in life saving efforts. Port Orange

21 Fire/Rescue Personnel were summoned to the Holding Facility with EVAC Personnel. Port Orange Fire/Rescue Personnel and EVAC Personnel

22 continued medical treatment of Randy Wilson before transporting Randy Wilson to the Halifax Medical Center (Daytona Beach). At the time

23 Randy Wilson was transported to the Hospital, his status was considered "critical." After Randy Wilson was transported to the Hospital, Patrol

24 Officers sealed the Holding Facility and initiated a crime scene log.

26 The Port Orange Criminal Investigations Division was notified of the incident and it was at that point I was notified to respond to the Police

27 Department to assist. Port Orange Lieutenant and Criminal Investigations Division Commander Scott Brozio responded to the Police Department.

28 Lieutenant Scott Brozio after being briefed on the situation ensured the Patrol Vehicle in which Randy Wilson was transported to the Port Orange

29 Police Department was sealed. Upon my arrival, I conducted a non-invasive walk-through of the Holding Facility in an effort to have an

30 understanding of the situation. It should be noted that Port Orange Detective Jeff Wenzel responded to the Halifax Medical Center (Daytona

31 Beach). Detective Jeff Wenzel relayed information to Lieutenant Scott Brozio and myself that Randy Wilson's status had not improved and was

32 still considered critical.

34 At this point, given the status of Randy Wilson; Lieutenant Scott Brozio contacted the Florida Department of Law Enforcement to conduct an

35 investigation into the circumstances surrounding Randy Wilson's medical episode. I assisted the Florida Department of Law Enforcement with

36 their investigation and conducted liaison duties to ensure the Florida Department of Law Enforcement had access to any evidence, areas of the

37 Police Department, and personnel needed to conduct their investigation. At this point, the Florida Department of Law Enforcement is the

38 investigating Agency and point of contact for the investigation into the circumstances surrounding Randy Wilson's medical episode.
