Since April 2008, the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) has received and documented no less than fourteen (14) separate complaints / requests for investigations from you regarding various allegations against current or former officials with the Volusia County Division of Corrections. Most of the documents attached and/or referenced in the website www.volusiaexposed.com are the same documents that you have previously forwarded to us with your requests. Each of your requests and the documents provided have been documented in an investigative report (IR) and in most instances a response was provided to you from an FDLE official either by correspondence or electronic mail (*investigative reports and responses have been attached to this e-mail for your review*).

As indicated in the November 24, 2009 correspondence from our Office of General Counsel, your complaints have been reviewed by members of four separate FDLE sections; The Criminal Justice Professionalism Program; the Investigations and Forensics Program; the Inspector General's Office; and the Office of Executive Investigations. In each review, none of these sections found your complaints to contain a criminal predicate that would support the initiation of a criminal investigation by our agency. We have also provided you with recommendations on how to further pursue your complaints and/or referred your complaints to the appropriate entity for review and any action they deemed appropriate.

In closing, your continuing to forward additional complaints regarding similar issues will not change the response of our agency.
