NARRATIVE The undersigned certifies and swears that there is probable cause to believe the above-named defendant,

on the 28 day of June, 2022, at approximately 0541 a.m.  a.m.  p.m.

at 1300 Red John Road DAYTONA BEACH within Volusia County, violated the law and did then and there:

- 1 actually and intentionally touched another against their will without causing injury, to wit:

3 On 07/14/22 at approximately 1030 hours, Detective Sergeant Tucker was requested to respond to New Smyrna Beach Police Department (NSBPD);  
4 at 246 Industrial Park Ave., New Smyrna, in reference to an alleged battery. The aforementioned incident occurred at the Volusia County Branch Jail  
5 (VCBJ) on 06/28/22 between two on-duty law enforcement officers.

6  
7 Sergeant Tucker responded to NSBPD and made contact with the complainant, \_\_\_\_\_ (the victim). \_\_\_\_\_ provided the following sworn  
8 statement:  
9

10 \_\_\_\_\_ is a sworn law enforcement officer with NSBPD and has been for approximately two years. During her tenure with the department, \_\_\_\_\_ was a  
11 co-worker with a former NSBPD law enforcement officer (now presently a sworn law enforcement officer with Edgewater Police Department),  
12 Kristofer Beatty (the defendant). \_\_\_\_\_ and Beatty briefly worked on the same shift and were zone partners during \_\_\_\_\_ training phase. Once  
13 released from training, \_\_\_\_\_ was assigned to a different shift, in which her contact with Beatty was limited to brief moments coming into work or  
14 leaving work. \_\_\_\_\_ described her relationship with Beatty to be exclusively professional, meaning the two had no personal relationship or  
15 communication outside of work-related matters. Approximately three to four months ago, Beatty voluntarily left NSBPD and was hired as a police

16 officer with Edgewater Police Department (EPD). Since Beatty's separation from NSBPD, [redacted] has not seen Beatty in person, and has only  
 17 communicated with him for official purposes regarding active calls between the two agencies. [redacted] advised this communication was likely via radio,  
 18 or the computer automated dispatch system (CAD), which is shared amongst all Volusia County Law Enforcement Agencies. [redacted] advised she did  
 19 not consider her and Beatty to be friends; however, the two did not have any disdain for one another.

20  
 21 On 06/28/22 at approximately 1740 hours, [redacted] was at VCBJ to turn over an arrestee of her's to corrections personnel. At this time, [redacted] had given  
 22 over her arrestee to personnel and was awaiting for the arrestee to be booked before she left the jail (officers have to wait for medical clearance of  
 23 the arrestee, a search of the arrestee, and the corrections staff to affirm receipt of paperwork before leaving). While [redacted] waited she was standing in  
 24 a secure vestibule area between the parking garage and the booking office. This area is secured by metal doors on either side and is a hallway  
 25 known by law enforcement personnel as the intake area. Police officers will congregate here with other law enforcement officers while they wait. At  
 26 approximately 1741 hours, [redacted] was standing against the wall on her cell phone when the metal door leading to the parking garage opened and EPI  
 27 Officer Kristopher Beatty entered. As Beatty entered he turned to his left and observed NSBPD Officer [redacted] and walked toward her. [redacted]  
 28 was between the entrance door and the intake officer's window, against the wall looking down at her cell phone, unaware he walked in. Beatty then  
 29 takes his left hand and greets [redacted] by slapping her face near her jaw and right ear. [redacted] was taken by surprise and looked up, seeing it was Beatty,  
 30 whom had just slapped her. [redacted] advised she immediately confronted Beatty and told him something to the effect of, "If you touch me like that again  
 31 I'll fuck you up". After confronting Beatty in this manner, he laughed it off. Beatty then continued his intake process by completing paperwork and  
 32 communicating with corrections personnel inside the intake pod. Beatty then turned to [redacted] and started conversing with her. While conversing, Beatty  
 33 attempted to get [redacted] attention by using his left arm and elbow to nudge her, so she would look at him. [redacted] and Beatty then began to discuss a ca  
 34 that NSBPD and EPD officers, including the two of them, worked that day. During the discussion, Beatty leaned over [redacted] (who was again using her  
 35 phone) and asked her something to the effect of, "What are you telling on me now?" [redacted] affirmed at this time she was texting her sergeant that  
 36 Beatty had slapped her. [redacted] then walked away from Beatty and had her back turned to him while she awaited her handcuffs from corrections  
 37 personnel. It was at this time, Beatty then walked over to [redacted] and put his left arm around her shoulder and neck. [redacted] then separates herself from  
 38 Beatty and confronts him again about his behavior, explaining it was unacceptable and unprofessional. [redacted] and Beatty then resume conversation  
 39 about the aforementioned call between the two agencies until [redacted] leaves the jail. This entire interaction lasted approximately ten minutes.

40  
 41 [redacted] then provided Sergeant Tucker with a copy of video surveillance from VCBJ. Sergeant Tucker and [redacted] then viewed the video surveillance  
 42 together. While watching the video, [redacted] provided her account of the incident while Sergeant Tucker watched it, in an effort to provide context, as the  
 43 video surveillance is not equipped with audio.

*How did the victim get a copy of a confidential jail video?*

44  
 45 Upon review, Sergeant Tucker made the following observations:

46  
 47 At 1741 hours, Officer Kristofer Beatty walks into the intake hallway and turns toward [redacted] whom is seemingly unaware he has walked in, as she is  
 48 looking down at her cellphone. As Beatty is walking toward [redacted] and the intake window he takes his left hand and pats the side of [redacted] face. The  
 49 contact was with enough force it made [redacted] head and upper body move, subsequently directing [redacted] attention to Beatty. [redacted] and Beatty then  
 50 began an inaudible conversation. At approximately 1743 hours, Beatty uses his elbow to nudge [redacted] in what appears to be an effort to get her  
 51 attention. Although there is actual contact, it is minor. The two continue an inaudible conversation; however, Beatty turns his attention to the intake  
 52 window and [redacted] returns her attention to her cellphone. Beatty then leans over [redacted] to look at her cell phone. In response, [redacted] pulls her phone into  
 53 her body and takes her hand to make a stop motion. Upon seeing this, Sergeant Tucker asked [redacted] what was being discussed, to which [redacted] stated  
 54 she told him to stop and that he (Beatty) was in her space. At 1744 hours, [redacted] walks away from Beatty. Beatty follows her and at 17:44:44 hours,  
 55 Beatty puts his left arm around [redacted] shoulders and neck. After a brief moment [redacted] separates herself from Beatty and her body language suggest  
 56 she is uncomfortable and upset. [redacted] then appears to confront Beatty as she is more animated in her inaudible conversation to include her  
 57 re-enacting her being elbowed [redacted] takes her arm and re-enacts how Beatty elbowed her to get her attention). Upon seeing this, Sergeant Tucker  
 58 asks [redacted] what's being discussed, to which she says she is confronting Beatty about his behavior. At approximately 1748 hours, both [redacted] and  
 59 Beatty leave the intake hallway and enter the garage. At 1750 hours, [redacted] leaves the parking garage.

60  
 61 Sergeant Tucker then asked [redacted] to provide the text messages she exchanged with her sergeant regarding the incident. [redacted] provided the  
 62 messages, to which Sergeant Tucker observed she did in fact text her Sergeant, Richard Kirkland, about the slap on 6/28/22 at approximately 1743  
 63 hours. [redacted] provided Sergeant Tucker with a copy of this message.

64  
 65 [redacted] advised she was uninjured as a result of the slap and the elbowing and affirmed she wished to pursue charges against Beatty.  
 66 [redacted] was verbally sworn to her statement, which was audio recorded and submitted to evidence. [redacted] completed a Marsy's Law form wherein she

67 elected to have her information remain confidential.

68

69 Sergeant Tucker then contacted VCBJ Lieutenant Michael Gallenkamp to retrieve a second copy of the aforementioned video surveillance. Sergeant

70 Tucker received this copy from Gallenkamp on 07/15/22. Sergeant Tucker reviewed this video affirming it was the same video surveillance as

71 provided by [REDACTED]. This copy of video surveillance was submitted into evidence along with [REDACTED] copy.

72

73 On 07/18/22, Sergeant Tucker made contact with Beatty via telephone to set an appointment for an interview. After making contact with Beatty,

74 Sergeant Tucker was contacted by Beatty's attorney, Greg Forhan. Forhan advised he was employed with the Coastal Florida PBA and was hired to

75 represent Beatty in this matter. Forhan advised he and Beatty would meet with Sergeant Tucker at his (Sergeant Tucker's) office for an interview on

76 07/19/22.

77

78 On 07/19/22 at approximately 1000 hours, Sergeant Tucker met with Beatty and Forhan. Upon making contact with both, Sergeant Tucker explained

79 that this interview was completely voluntary. Sergeant Tucker explained that he (Beatty) was not detained, no arrest would occur, and the door was

80 unlocked and how he could exit the office. Sergeant Tucker explained that he did not have to participate in the interview and could, at any time, stop

81 the interview or refuse to answer any questions. Additionally, Sergeant Tucker affirmed this was a criminal investigation and he (Sergeant Tucker)

82 had no affiliation with either NSBPD or EPD, nor did this interview conducted by Sergeant Tucker have anything to do with any administrative action

83 by his (Beatty's) department. With Forhan (his attorney) present, Beatty affirmed he understood this.

84

85 Prior to any questioning, Forhan requested an opportunity to review the video surveillance with Sergeant Tucker and Beatty. Sergeant Tucker played

86 the video surveillance for them. After reviewing, Forhan asked Beatty if he was ready to proceed with the interview, to which he stated he was.

87 Sergeant Tucker then conducted an audio recorded interview with Beatty, who advised the following:

88

89 Beatty was formerly employed with NSBPD. While so employed with NSBPD, Beatty met and befriended [REDACTED]. Beatty advised [REDACTED] was briefly on hi

90 shift while she was in her training phase. At some point during their time together at the department, an officer involved shooting occurred. Following

91 this incident the two spoke more often regarding work related stress and how to cope with the incident. Beatty advised he felt the two were friends;

92 however, affirmed neither saw each other outside of work or spent time together unless it was at work and pertaining to official business. Beatty and

93 [REDACTED] were friendly to each other as they were co-workers and nothing more. Beatty advised he separated from NSBPD for an employment

94 opportunity with EPD a few months ago. Upon leaving NSBPD, Beatty has not seen [REDACTED]. Beatty advised the two may have conversed via radio or

95 CAD for official purposes prior to the incident date; however, he was unsure.

96

97 On 06/28/22, at approximately 1740 hours, Beatty brought an arrestee to VCBJ to be processed. Upon arriving at the jail, Beatty entered and to his

98 surprise, [REDACTED] was standing there. Upon seeing [REDACTED], Beatty walked past her and tapped her with his hand to say hello. Beatty advised he believed

99 he intended to tap her shoulder and may have inadvertently tapped her face. Beatty advised he in no way intended to harm or upset [REDACTED] nor did he

100 intent to strike her face. Beatty advised he felt the two were close enough having worked together that the touching would have been acceptable.

101 Beatty continued that as a law enforcement officer this behavior is often exhibited amongst fellow law enforcement officers.

102

103 When asked if Beatty recalled being confronted by [REDACTED] on two occasions, he said he did not recall being confronted about him touching [REDACTED], and if

104 he had, he certainly wouldn't have touched her again. When Sergeant Tucker referenced [REDACTED] placing her hand up in a motion that clearly and

105 universally signifies "Stop", he said he did not remember this occurring until he was shown the video by Sergeant Tucker. When asked about the

106 second time [REDACTED] confronted him, wherein she was demonstrating the elbow movement he had used to get her attention, he said he again did not

107 recall it occurring until being shown the video. After seeing the video on this day, he acknowledged what Sergeant Tucker saw, but did not recall [REDACTED]

108 saying to him that she would "fuck him up" or not to touch her. Beatty advised if this had occurred he would have apologized and obviously not

109 nudged her or put his arm around her if he knew or thought it was unwelcomed. Beatty advised he was just being friendly and it was a form of

110 expression. Beatty advised law enforcement officers often mess around with each other and often engage in horseplay. Beatty did not consider these

111 actions to be offensive horseplay, but rather a standard interaction between two fellow law enforcement officers, whom were friends. Beatty

112 apologized multiple times and affirmed he in no way intended to hurt [REDACTED] or cause her distress. Beatty did not dispute any actions observed on

113 video, but repeated his stance that he would never have touched [REDACTED] had he known she did not want to be touched. Beatty was verbally sworn to

114 his statement, which was audio recorded and submitted into evidence.

115

116 Through the investigation, Sergeant Tucker has determined Beatty actually and intentionally touched [REDACTED] against her will on three separate

117 occasions, contrary to Florida State Statute 784.03. Beatty first tapped the face of [REDACTED] then elbowed her, and lastly places his arm around her



118 shoulder and neck. Per [redacted] statement, two acts of touching (the elbow and should grab) were after Beatty had been told not to touch [redacted] and al  
 119 three acts of touching were against her will. Video surveillance was collected and viewed by Sergeant Tucker, which corroborates [redacted] statement.  
 120 During an interview with Beatty, he admitted to touching Beatty three times as the video surveillance shows; however, indicated he was unaware it  
 121 was unwanted at the time.  
 122  
 123 Based on the totality of the incident coupled with the time lapse, Sergeant Tucker elected to file the charge of simple battery with office of the state  
 124 attorney in lieu of a physical arrest.


