EE – Lt. Erik Eagan      MA – Michael Allcock

On May 23, 2012 at 1344 hours LT Eagan called Michael Allcock at 407-416-1745.  
Below is a summary of the conversation with him during the sworn phone interview.

EE    Hello Mr. Allcock?

MA    Yeah.

EE    Hello I'm Erik Eagan with the Volusia County Sheriff's Office. I'm conducting  
an administrative investigation. Would you mind if I spoke with you?

MA    No

EE    Would you mind if I recorded our conversation?

MA    I would prefer if you did not.

EE    OK. (recorder shut off)

EE    Can you spell you name for me please?

MA    A-L-L-C-O-C-K

EE    What is your address?

MA    4711 South Hampton Drive, Orlando, FL 32812

EE    What was the zip code again?

35 EE OK. Thank you, please bear with me as I write down my notes.

39 EE What is your date of birth?

43 EE Is your phone number the number I just called you? (407-416-1745)

47 EE How do you know Deputy Deane?

49 MA Ahhh, we've been good friends for 7-8 years now.

51 EE Were you at a party on November 5, 2011 at Deputy Deane's house?

53 MA I was.

55 EE What kind of party was it?

56

57 MA It was a gathering of friends watching the football game and a post Halloween  
58 party of sorts.

60 EE Did you wear a costume and if so what were you dressed up as?

61

62 MA I did and it was all of about 7 minutes. I was dressed as the character from Scary  
63 Movie, it was a black jumpsuit that I grew tired of and took off.  
64  
65 EE How were you invited to the party?  
66  
67 MA Travis invited me.  
68  
69 EE How did he invite you?  
70  
71 MA Over the phone, I talk to him just about everyday.  
72  
73 EE Did you see two young teenage girls at the party?  
74  
75 MA There were girls there. I don't recall anyone in the teenage range.  
76  
77 EE Do you remember two girls that looked younger than most of the girls at the  
78 party?  
79  
80 MA I don't. All the girls there looked to be in the same age range. I don't remember  
81 the girls' names, but I think one of them was named [REDACTED].  
82  
83 EE One of the girls' names was [REDACTED].  
84  
85 EE Do you remember how they were dressed?  
86  
87 MA No.  
88  
89 EE Did you have a conversation with them?  
90  
91 MA Not that I recall.

93 EE How old did you think the girls were?  
94  
95 MA 25-30  
96  
97 EE Did Deputy Deane introduce them to you?  
98  
99 MA No.  
100  
101 EE I think I got a bit ahead of myself. I need to swear you in. As a Florida Law  
102 Enforcement Officer and a Notary Public of the State of Florida I am empowered  
103 to take sworn statements. At this time I'd ask that you to raise your right hand to  
104 be sworn please.  
105  
106 Do you solemnly swear or affirm that the statement you are about to give is the  
107 truth, the whole truth and nothing but the truth so help you God?  
108  
109 MA Yes, I do.  
110  
111 EE Up until the point that I swore you in have you answered all of my questions  
112 truthfully and accurately?  
113  
114 MA Yes I have.  
115  
116 EE Did you see Deputy Deane serve alcohol to either of the teenage girls?  
117  
118 MA Not at any point.  
119  
120 EE Did you see anybody at the party serve alcohol to the teenage girls?  
121  
122 MA Not that I recall no.

124 EE Was the alcohol available to the people in attendance?  
125  
126 MA Yes.  
127  
128 EE Where was the alcohol located?  
129  
130 MA In the garage.  
131  
132 EE How was the alcohol available?  
133  
134 MA The alcohol was in the refrigerator in the garage. I guess you could call it a  
135 kegerator. It had a keg in it.  
136  
137 EE Did you see either girl with a plastic cup in their hand?  
138  
139 MA Umm, I think so.  
140  
141 EE Did you see either girl consume alcohol while at the party?  
142  
143 MA Umm, I didn't see them pour or drink any alcohol. I don't know what they had in  
144 their cups.  
145  
146 EE Did you see the plastic cups on the patrol car's hood?  
147  
148 MA Ahhh, at one point yeah.  
149  
150 EE Did you play beer pong on the hood of the patrol car?  
151  
152 MA I did not.  
153  
154 EE Who was playing beer pong on the patrol car?

156 MA Umm, I honestly don't. I was inside most of the time watching the LSU Alabama  
157 game. I went outside once for a cigarette and I saw, I think Clayton playing and  
158 another female.

160 EE Where was Deputy Deane when people were playing beer pong on the patrol car?

161

162 MA Umm, he was in his bedroom. I mean, he was in the garage earlier in the night  
163 and later. I mean before and after the beer pong.

165 EE Who was he with?

166

167 MA I don't know for sure.

169 EE What characters were playing beer pong?

170

171 MA Marge Simpson – I don't remember who that was.

173 EE What character was Clayton?

174

175 MA Clayton was a terrorist or something like that.

177 EE If the beer was in the garage, could you see the patrol car with the plastic cups on  
178 the hood from there?

180 MA Yeah, I mean the garage isn't that big.

182 EE Where is the patrol car in relation to the garage?


184 MA It was the first car in the driveway, right up next to the garage.

186 EE Did Deputy Deane see the plastic cups on the patrol car?

188 MA When he came out at the end of the night, but there was no game in progress, they  
189 were just left over sitting on the car.

191 EE What time did the party start?  
192  
193 MA Somewhere between 9:00-10:00.  
194  
195 EE Is that PM?  
196  
197 MA Yes sir.  
198  
199 EE What time did you leave the party?  
200  
201 MA Somewhere between 1:30 and 2:00, I know it was before two because I had to  
202 work the next morning. I'm guessing it was closer to two when I left.  
203  
204 EE Now would that be AM?  
205  
206 MA Yes sir.  
207  
208 EE Is there anything else you would like to add or delete from your statement?  
209  
210 MA No sir.  
211  
212 EE Thank you for your time today.  
213  
214 MA No problem.  
215  
216 The interview concluded at 1359 hours.
