

NARRATIVE / CONTINUATION

11 heard the car horn/alarm going off at which time she walked out to the garage to see why the horn/alarm was going off. Matthew Tremblay and  
 12 [REDACTED] were inside the SUV at the time. [REDACTED] waited in the garage to see what was going on with the vehicle. Matthew  
 13 Tremblay told her to go back inside. [REDACTED] refused stating this was her house and for him to leave. The argument continued in the  
 14 driveway where [REDACTED] and Matthew Tremblay were yelling at each other. [REDACTED] asked Matthew Tremblay if he was going to hit  
 15 her because his daughter was near him. [REDACTED] told him to leave which he declined and told her to leave instead.  
 16  
 17 Matthew Tremblay then threw the keys to the SUV at [REDACTED] yelling, "It's yours, take it. I'm done." He was still yelling in her face and was  
 18 spitting on her. [REDACTED] pushed him back in order to gain distance. [REDACTED] and Matthew Tremblay discussed if he in fact spit on her.  
 19 Matthew Tremblay apologized for spitting on her, and it was only because he was too close to her when yelling.  
 20  
 21 Matthew Tremblay entered the garage where [REDACTED] followed him and the argument continued. [REDACTED] began to back up with her  
 22 hands open. Matthew Tremblay then proceeded to grab her left wrist and twisted it back hard enough to hold her in place. [REDACTED] told him  
 23 to let her go, but he continued to yell in her face. [REDACTED] reached into her back pocket with her free hand, grabbing her phone, and told him  
 24 she was going to call [REDACTED]. Matthew Tremblay stated, "No you wouldn't ", but it was not until [REDACTED] dialed the phone, he let go. [REDACTED]  
 25 [REDACTED] stayed on the line with the operator, as Matthew Tremblay walked away and immediately calmed down. Matthew Tremblay remained  
 26 calm until Deputy Martir and Deputy Martin's arrival.  
 27  
 28 Deputy Martir later made contact with Matthew Tremblay who was inside the residence. Matthew Tremblay advised he and his wife were  
 29 discussing renovations to the house. Matthew Tremblay was asked to measure the bed in one of the rooms. He went to the garage and grabbed a  
 30 tape measurer. While attempting to measure, [REDACTED] asked/told him to do something else. [REDACTED] began to use the tape measurer  
 31 to measure the closet in the bedroom. While she was talking to [REDACTED] Matthew Tremblay reached for the tape measurer to use it.  
 32 She pulled it back and would not let him have it. Matthew Tremblay advised he let it go and was eventually able to use the tape measurer and  
 33 measure the bed again. [REDACTED] then came into the bedroom where he was and began yelling at him. He asked her to leave the room and  
 34 to leave him alone. When she refused, he walked out of the house through the garage and began to clean his SUV. [REDACTED] later came out  
 35 of the residence and started yelling at him once more. Again telling her to leave him alone, Matthew Tremblay walked away back into the garage.  
 36 While in the garage, [REDACTED] raised her hand as if to hit him. Matthew Tremblay stated he grabbed her left arm to keep her from hitting him.  
 37 He let go of her arm and they both went their separate ways.  
 38  
 39 Matthew Trembalay added in hindsight, [REDACTED] probably was not going to hit him, but was flailing her arms around due to the level of  
 40 arguing.  
 41  
 42 Contact was made with [REDACTED] in her bedroom who advised she was outside by the SUV with her father when he and her step-mother  
 43 were arguing. She initaly stated she though she saw her step-mother push her father but recanted and stated due to standing directly behind her  
 44 father all she saw was him stumble back as if he was pushed. [REDACTED] did not see the altercation inside the garage.  
 45  
 46 [REDACTED] completed a sworn written statement detailing the events of the incident and ended her statement on how she did not wish to  
 47 pursue criminal charges against her husband. Deputy Martir took photographs of [REDACTED] left wrist which appeared to have slight swelling.  
 48 The photographs were later uploaded to the Digital Crime Scene Database. She was also provided a Domestic Abuse pamphlet detailing her  
 49 rights and remedies, for which she signed for.  
 50  
 51 Matthew Tremblay also completed a sworn written statement detailing the events of the incident.  
 52  
 53 Based off the statements made by both [REDACTED] Matthew, and [REDACTED] coupled with the complaint and presence of physical injury, Deputy  
 54 Martir determining Matthew Tremblay to be the primary aggressor and was placed under arrest for simple battery, domestic battery  
 55 Sgt. Genovese was notified and responded to the scene as well.  
 56  
 57 Matthew Tremblay was later transported to the Volusia County Branch Jail without further incident.

28 hands open. Matthew Tremblay then proceeded to grab her left wrist and twisted it back hard enough to hold her in place. [REDACTED] told him to  
29 let her go, but he continued to yell in her face. [REDACTED] reached into her back pocket with her free hand, grabbing her phone, and told him she  
30 was going to call [REDACTED]. Matthew Tremblay stated, "No you wouldn't", but it was not until [REDACTED] dialed the phone, he let go. [REDACTED]  
31 stayed on the line with the operator, as Matthew Tremblay walked away and immediately calmed down. Matthew Tremblay remained calm until  
32 Deputy Martir and Deputy Martin's arrival.  
33  
34 Deputy Martir later made contact with Matthew Tremblay who was inside the residence. Matthew Tremblay advised he and his wife were discussing  
35 renovations to the house. Matthew Tremblay was asked to measure the bed in one of the rooms. He went to the garage and grabbed a tape  
36 measurer. While attempting to measure, [REDACTED] asked/told him to do something else. [REDACTED] began to use the tape measurer to  
37 measure the closet in the bedroom. While she was talking to [REDACTED] Matthew Tremblay reached for the tape measurer to use it. She  
38 pulled it back and would not let him have it. Matthew Tremblay advised he let it go and was eventually able to use the tape measurer and measure  
39 the bed again. [REDACTED] then came into the bedroom where he was and began yelling at him. He asked her to leave the room and to leave him  
40 alone. When she refused, he walked out of the house through the garage and began to clean his SUV. [REDACTED] later came out of the residence  
41 and started yelling at him once more. Again telling her to leave him alone, Matthew Tremblay walked away back into the garage. While in the garage,  
42 [REDACTED] raised her hand as if to hit him. Matthew Tremblay stated he grabbed her left arm to keep her from hitting him. He let go of her arm  
43 and they both went their separate ways.  
44  
45 Matthew Tremblay added in hindsight, [REDACTED] probably was not going to hit him, but was flailing her arms around due to the level of arguing.  
46  
47 Contact was made with [REDACTED] in her bedroom who advised she was outside by the SUV with her father when he and her step-mother  
48 were arguing. She initially stated she though she saw her step-mother push her father but recanted and stated due to standing directly behind her  
49 father all she saw was him stumble back as if he was pushed. [REDACTED] did not see the altercation inside the garage.  
50  
51 [REDACTED] completed a sworn written statement detailing the events of the incident and ended her statement on how she did not wish to pursue  
52 criminal charges against her husband. Deputy Martir took photographs of [REDACTED] left wrist which appeared to have slight swelling. The  
53 photographs were later uploaded to the Digital Crime Scene Database. She was also provided a Domestic Abuse pamphlet detailing her rights and  
54 remedies, for which she signed for.  
55  
56 Matthew Tremblay also completed a sworn written statement detailing the events of the incident.  
57  
58 Based off the statements made by both [REDACTED] Matthew, and [REDACTED] coupled with the complaint and presence of physical injury, Deputy  
59 Martir determining Matthew Tremblay to be the primary aggressor and was placed under arrest for simple battery, domestic battery  
60 Sgt. Genovese was notified and responded to the scene as well.  
61  
62 Matthew Tremblay was later transported to the Volusia County Branch Jail without further incident.
