Director Demore:

Over the last five (5) years, our organization (**VolusiaExposed.Com**) has published several articles in which we opine that Volusia Sheriff Mike Chitwood, while assisted by a cabal of justice practitioners (**judge, prosecutor, and the public defender**), knowingly pushed a false charging narrative against two juvenile defendants. (**Travis O'Brien (12), Nicole Jackson (14)**)

In short, that these children attempted to murder several Volusia sheriff deputies. (**see the below linked media article for additional context and details**)

We have argued, and have provided evidence, that the children are factually innocent of these attempted murder charges, The children did factually break into a home, causing major damage to the interior of that structure.

However, regardless of Sheriff Chitwood's media statement (**see below linked video**) – the children did **NOT** fire numerous rounds from a military type rifle at his deputies. As supported by Volusia Sheriff Investigator Cordell Lemay's report (**see below linked copy**) – the AK-47 rifle was **NOT** fired – the children only fired four (4) rounds from a small caliber hand gun, and two (2) shot gun rounds.

Further evidence suggests - that these six (6) rounds were fired within the home – and were in furtherance to the interior damage to that structure.

O'Brien was eventually prosecuted as a juvenile, while Ms. Jackson was prosecuted as an adult, and is currently serving a twenty (20) year prison sentence (**via a judicially coerced plea deal**).

We believe that the **SEALED** court transcript from a January 27, 2023 hearing fully supports that Circuit Court Judge Elizabeth Blackburn, acting as an agent of the cabal, **judicially coerced** Ms. Jackson, **a then fifteen year-old child**, into accepting a plea deal with prosecutors (**see below linked copy of this court transcript**).

While Judge Blackburn initially attempted to hide her coercive tactics behind a **CLOSED** courtroom door, and a **SEALED** transcript – the transcript was eventually inadvertently leaked by the Volusia County Clerk of the Court.

The above transcript also supports that Judge Blackburn assigned Assistant Public Defender Larry Avallone – a former Volusia sheriff deputy – as Ms. Jackson's defense counsel. Due to the recent arrest of Volusia County Correctional Officer T. Joyal for perjury in her official capacity as an officer (**see the below linked arrest report**), we now question whether members of your agency also assisted this syndicate by impeding Ms. Jackson's efforts in securing effective defense counsel.

In early January 2023 the prosecution, and others became aware that Ms. Jackson was attempting to secure the services of a private attorney to replace Assistant Public Defender Avallone (**a member of this nefarious syndicate**). Per the court transcript – members of this syndicate were listening into Ms. Jackson's phone conversations regarding her desire to seek a new attorney that would take her case to trial (**see below linked pages 45-47 from the hearing transcript**)(**other evidence is available to support the phone tap**).

On January 14, 2023 Correctional Officer P. Hall # 22172 filed an in-house jail disciplinary report #230004787 (**see below linked copy**) whereas Officer Hall alleges that Ms. Jackson was threatening to kill correctional staff members – and that Ms. Jackson was going to allege that her attorney was looking at her in a sexual way – so she could have him fired.

Suspiciously, no formal criminal charges were filed against Ms. Jackson for these alleged threats to kill.

Four days later, on January 18, 2023 Correctional Officer T. Joyal # 24047 filed a supplement report – making a similar accounting of Ms. Jackson’s alleged threats and statements. On January 19, 2023 - upon being questioned by investigative jail staff, Ms. Jackson adamantly denied threatening any staff members. (see the above linked copy of report)

During the January 27, 2023 court hearing (see linked hearing transcription) Mr. Avallone stated that he was aware of Ms. Jackson’s housing status within the jail – and that it had recently changed.

We have concerns that Mr. Avallone may have been aware of Officer Hall’s and Officer Joyal’s reports that Ms. Jackson had allegedly made **accusations of sexual misconduct** against him. If so, this may have biased Mr. Avallone’s ability to fairly represent Ms. Jackson during the January 27, 2023 plea and sentencing hearing, **thereby insuring that Ms. Jackson had ineffective counsel during said hearing.**

Additionally, we have concerns that the entire narrative within this disciplinary report is fraudulent. We suspect that the disciplinary report is a work of fiction - manufactured for the sole purpose of placing Ms. Jackson in a housing status (**disciplinary segregation**) that would have forbid her having any telephonic communications - thereby impeding Ms. Jackson’s ability to secure a private attorney.

We further opine that such nefarious actions were requested by this cartel of justice practitioners – through the jail’s administration. Honestly, given the corruption – that your agency has self verified as being active within this time frame (early 2023) – it’s no stretch of the imagination to wonder if correctional staff were assisting this cabal – in violating Ms. Jackson’s right to due process of law. Our concerns are further bolstered – given the fact, that both Officer Hall and Officer Joyal stated within their reports, that Ms. Jackson’s disciplinary incident transpired on January 14, 2023 - starting at **“approximately 0940 hours”**.

HOWEVER, according the jail’s in-house report generation and tracking system (**Beacon Software Solutions – see last page of disciplinary report**) – Officer Hall requested the assignment of the report’s tracking number at 0607 hours – over three and half (**3.5**) **hours prior** to Ms. Jackson’s disciplinary transgressions / statements. This advance knowledge of needing a report number – prior to the occurrence of the event – paints a picture of a staged and fictionalized incident.

In closing, in February 2025 a private attorney filed a post conviction appeal in this case, arguing that Ms. Jackson did indeed receive ineffective counsel. Judge Blackburn promptly ordered that this motion for appeal also be sealed – but like the court transcript, it too was inadvertently leaked by the Clerk of the Court. (see the below linked copy).
