82 **Sergeant Maxwell - Handgun**

83 **Make:** Glock

84 **Model:** 34

85 **Caliber:** 9mm

86 **Serial:** BRRY507

87 **Condition:** Features a light. Inserted magazine contained 13 cartridges, chamber contained 1 cartridge. Spare magazines contained 17

88 cartridges each.

90 The firearms used were collected as evidence as well as the associated ammunition and magazine(s).

91

92 Detective Mott issued loaner handguns to Sergeant Maxwell, Deputy Zimmerman, and Deputy Richardson.

94 **Scene**

95

96 On the morning of 06/02/21 Detective Mott responded for the first time to 1050 Enterprise-Osteen Rd., the location of incident which had been

97 initially attended to by Detective Mefford the previous night. It was decided Detective Mott would focus efforts on the documentation and collection

98 of the evidence related to the officers' shooting positions around the exterior of the house while Detective Mefford focused on the interior of the

99 house.

100

101 The property is described as agricultural acreage, fenced as cow pasture with an active herd of cattle on the property. There is a single story

102 house situated in the center of one pasture surrounded by a typical cattle fence with gates, beyond that a much larger primary pasture. There is a

103 concrete driveway extending several hundred feet from the roadway, and an attached three-car garage. The home is brick or brick façade with a

104 concrete tile roof. The property is largely cleared though there are several mature oak trees surrounding the house.

106 Detective Mott was accompanied throughout the scene investigation by FDLE Special Agent Scott Ratliff.

108 Through combined search efforts several clusters of fired shell cases were located around the east, northeast, and north side of the home. Four

109 distinct shooting positions were identified through this process, all apparently using the oak trees as cover.

111 Yellow numbered placards were used to aid in the visibility of items collected, as seen in photographs taken by Detective Mott. Where practical,

112 clusters of shell cases were recorded with one placard to improve the efficiency of cataloging and collection.

113

114 Placards #1-24 were used to delineate deputies' fired shell cases within the yard of residence. The shell cases were collected as evidence.

116 A subsequent search of the property on 06/03 yielded a piece of metal within the exposed root of an oak tree on the north side of the residence.

117 Detective Mott cut out the section of the root to expose what appeared to be a large caliber projectile. There was significant weathering in the form

118 of oxidation on the projectile as well as decaying wood surrounding the projectile, indicating to Detective Mott it was not temporaneous. It was

119 collected nonetheless and is featured using placard #25.
