The undersigned certifies and swears that there is probable cause to believe the above-named defendant, on the 6th day of July, 2024, at approximately 11:00 hours at [REDACTED] Port Orange, FL, violated the law and did then and there:

Narrative Title: Narrative

****Marsy's Law Invoked****

There is digital evidence of this incident uploaded to Evidence.com.

On July 9th, 2024, at approximately 1345 hours, Port Orange Police were dispatched to [REDACTED] for a domestic disturbance. The original notes from dispatch stated the reporting party, later identified by FLDL as [REDACTED] reported her husband Mark Dickinson left the home two days prior and closed out the family's bank accounts. [REDACTED] also stated Mark was currently at the home and was destroying items inside. [REDACTED] further reported her husband was a former law enforcement officer and had numerous firearms in his possession.

Officers arrived and met with [REDACTED] in a nearby parking lot, where she was accompanied by a family friend. The couple's two children, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were also present. [REDACTED] appeared distraught and stated she was concerned for the safety of Mark and for the safety of her family if she chose to re-enter the home. [REDACTED] further stated that on July 6th, 2024 at approximately 1100 hours, she was at her home and received a message from Mark to look for his phone. It should be noted Mark has several phones used for various work-related purposes. [REDACTED] began searching through a pile of Mark's clothing and located the cellular phone in the pocket of a pair of pants. Due to previous infidelity in the relationship, [REDACTED] began looking through the phone as she had raised suspicions of new infidelity. [REDACTED] located a series of text message between Mark and another woman, who she was told was his attorney. The messages contained numerous lewd photographs and other evidence of infidelity. [REDACTED] immediately contacted Mark and told him to gather his belongings and leave the home. Minutes later, Mark arrived at the home and an argument ensued. [REDACTED] stated Mark took her cellular phone in an attempt to delete the photos she sent to herself as evidence. As [REDACTED] struggled to retrieve her phone from Mark, he pushed her several times. [REDACTED] stated she became very sore afterwards and had several bruises on her chest and arms. According to [REDACTED] statement, the couple's two children were present for the entirety of the incident and were crying and screaming for the struggle to stop. Photos of [REDACTED] bruises were taken by Officer Vines and submitted to Evidence.com.

Following the struggle, [REDACTED] stated Mark began to make statements alluding to his intent to harm himself. Mark also made statements to his two children, saying that he was sorry that they had to witness the incident and that this was "goodbye". Mark then went into another room and retrieved his AR-15 style rifle and Glock pistol. Mark took hold of the Glock pistol and pointed it in his mouth, threatening to end his life. [REDACTED] stated after several moments of pleading with Mark, he abruptly put the firearm down and left the home. Mark did not return to the home until this morning at approximately 1030 hours. Mark sent a series of text messages to [REDACTED] asking her to remove the children from the home so that he could return to take his personal items. Mark also requested a pin code from [REDACTED] to cancel his cellular phone account, but [REDACTED] declined and turned the phone off herself. Mark also advised [REDACTED] via text that he was closing all of the family's bank accounts and stated he would leave cash for her at the residence. Once inside the residence, Mark sent [REDACTED] several additional text messages, including photos of furniture and electronic equipment he had destroyed with a baseball bat. [REDACTED] stated Mark's recent behavior has lead her to be in fear for her life and the lives of her children, leading her to call Police today. [REDACTED] provided a sworn written statement of the incident. [REDACTED] also invoked her Marsy's Rights and was issued a Victim's Rights Pamphlet.

On July 9, 2024, at approximately 1421 hours, Officer Vines contacted Brooke Roos via phone call in reference to this case. Brooke advised that her friend, [REDACTED] and her husband Mark Dickinson had engaged in a physical altercation on Saturday (07/06/24). It should be noted that Brooke did not observe this and that [REDACTED] contacted her via phone call after the incident occurred. [REDACTED] stated to Brooke that Mark was cheating due to her locating pictures of other women on his cell phone. Mark took [REDACTED] phone and [REDACTED] was able to get her phone back from Mark. Brooke advised that Mark supposedly pretended to faint on the floor after [REDACTED] retrieved her phone back. Brooke further advised that [REDACTED] had bruises on marks on her body from this altercation, however, she was uncertain of how [REDACTED] obtained them. Brooke additionally stated that Mark also held a gun to his mouth on Saturday, advising he would kill himself. This was not observed by Brooke. Brooke was verbally sworn to her statement over the phone.

It should be noted that throughout the encounter, Mark Dickinson was sending text messages to [REDACTED] and family friends. In these messages, Mark sent photos of the damaged items inside the home as well as requests for [REDACTED] not to disclose the incident to Police. While speaking with [REDACTED] at POPD, she received an additional text message from Mark, stating he had left the home and was picked up by a friend. [REDACTED] disclosed a possible address for Mark's girlfriend in Ormond Beach, FL. Ormond Beach Police were sent to the premise in an attempt to contact Mark. All attempts to contact Mark have been unsuccessful as of this time. A BOLO was sent out to all neighboring jurisdictions to attempt to locate Mark.

Officers later escorted [REDACTED] back to the residence to retrieve personal items. During the encounter, [REDACTED] made entry into the couple's Tesla vehicle, yielding the discovery of four firearms. The firearms were left in the custody of [REDACTED] for safekeeping.

I contacted the Department of Children and Families in regard to this incident. DCF call taker Sharday #509 advised that the agency will be opening an investigation into the matter.

Due to the facts and circumstances of this incident, there is probable cause to believe Mark Dickinson (DOB: [REDACTED]) (LKA: [REDACTED]) has violated Florida State Statutes. I will be filing a complaint affidavit in regard.
