NARRATIVE The undersigned certifies and swears that there is probable cause to believe the above-named defendant, on the 01 day of June, 2021, at approximately 0730 a.m. p.m. at 1050 Enterprise Osteen RD EDGEWATER within Volusia County, violated the law and did then and there:

1 On June 1st, 2021, Nicole Jackson (14 years old) and _____ ran away from the Florida United Methodist's Children's Home
 2 (FUMCH) in Enterprise, FL. After running away from FUMCH, the children proceeded to burglarize the residence located at 1050 Enterprise Osteen
 3 Road, Deltona. During the burglary of the home (in which the residents were not present) both Jackson and _____ armed themselves with several of
 4 the homeowner's guns. When deputies arrived to the burglary in progress, both Jackson and _____ used the firearms they had armed themselves
 5 with to assault (and then ultimately shoot and attempt to kill) the deputies. As a result of Jackson's and _____ actions, deputies were forced to
 6 protect themselves by returning fire. Jackson subsequently sustained multiple gunshot wounds while _____ did not sustain any injuries. None of the
 7 deputies who were fired upon were injured during the event.
 8
 9 The incident originated from a report of Jackson and _____ running away from FUMCH (51 Children's Way, Enterprise), shortly before 5 p.m.
 10 Deputies learned that _____ was a diabetic and didn't have his medication with him. It was also reported that Jackson had battered a FUMCH staff
 11 member with a stick earlier in the day.

 13 At approximately 6:17 p.m., Deputy Galarza observed a pending call for service reference 8 to 10 juvenile's swimming in the springs at Green Springs
 14 Park (984 Lakeshore Drive, Enterprise). Deputy Galarza responded in hopes of locating Jackson and _____ at the springs.
 15

16 Upon arrival at Green Springs Park, Deputy Galarza observed Jackson and [redacted] at the park. As soon as Jackson observed Deputy Galarza, she
 17 smiled and took off on foot towards the bike paths [redacted] followed closely behind Jackson and Deputy Galarza requested additional deputies
 18 respond to search for them. Even though deputies thoroughly searched the wooded area, neither Jackson nor [redacted] were located.

19
 20 At approximately 7:30 p.m., as deputies continued to search the area, a passerby witness reported hearing glass break and observed juveniles
 21 walking around 1050 Enterprise Osteen Road. As deputies approached the house, they saw signs of forced entry and observed two (2) figures in the
 22 home. Deputies contacted the homeowner, who told them no one should be inside of the residence, and that there was a handgun, a shotgun and an
 23 AK-47 inside, along with a large amount of ammunition.

24
 25 After deputies surrounded the home and began making announcements into the house, Jackson and [redacted] started shooting at them. Jackson
 26 subsequently fired a shot at a deputy out of a back patio door around 8:30 p.m. Over the course of approximately 30 minutes, both Jackson and
 27 [redacted] fired at deputies on multiple occasions. Jackson then exited the residence through the garage armed with a shotgun. Jackson subsequently
 28 pointed the shotgun at deputies. As a result of her (Jackson's) actions, deputies were forced to defend themselves by returning fire. Jackson
 29 sustained multiple gunshot wounds and deputies quickly acted to perform life saving measures. Also in the garage with Jackson, and armed with an
 30 AK-47, was [redacted]. After Jackson was shot, and deputies were providing her first aid, [redacted] surrendered without further incident. In the garage,
 31 deputies observed the AK-47 style rifle, a shotgun and a handgun.

32
 33 Jackson was transported to Central Florida Regional Hospital for further medical treatment. After undergoing surgery, she was reported to be in
 34 stable condition and ultimately transferred to Arnold Palmer Hospital in Orlando for further observation. [redacted] was not injured during the incident but
 35 transported to Advent Health Fish Memorial in Orange City for treatment of his medical condition.

 37 Detective McGuire responded to Advent Health Fish Memorial and interviewed [redacted] Detective McGuire conducted a sworn, audio recorded
 38 interview with [redacted] Detective McGuire read O'Brien his Miranda Rights from the Volusia Sheriff's Office Advice of Rights Juvenile Form. [redacted]
 39 advised he understood his rights and agreed to speak with Detective McGuire. O'Brien signed the form as well.

40
 41 [redacted] stated he has been at FUMCH for approximately 7 months and has ran away from there multiple times. He and Nicole ran away from the
 42 property this afternoon after school. [redacted] stated when they ran away from the facility they were confronted by Mr. Hunter, who is an employee at
 43 FUMCH. He said Jackson hit Mr. Hunter in the leg with a log and they ran from him. He advised they made their way to Green Springs and there they
 44 met up with four other male individuals. He stated he knew two of them, Devon Monroe and Zach Kennedy. He further stated he had never met the
 45 other two boys and did not know their names. He was able to provide basic descriptions for the four males.

46
 47 [redacted] said from Green Springs they (Jackson, O'Brien, Monroe, Kennedy and the other two males) could see a barn so they went to the property.
 48 The property [redacted] spoke of was 1050 Enterprise Osteen Road, Enterprise. He advised there were multiple buildings on the property, to include a
 49 shed and "half barn." He said while they were going through shed they found two boxes that contained rifle ammunition and a zip lock bag containing
 50 ammunition for a handgun. He stated one of the boys (unknown which one) made a statement to find guns since they found ammunition. [redacted]
 51 advised while they were on the property, behind one of the buildings, they saw people at the residence leave in a vehicle. He stated all of them broke
 52 windows and glass doors of the residence in an effort to gain access to the interior of it. [redacted] said he ([redacted] specifically used a crowbar, a
 53 shovel and large rocks to break windows and the rear sliding glass door. Detective McGuire asked [redacted] how many windows he broke and he said,
 54 "Every last one of them!"

55
 56 [redacted] stated the four boys ran off and only he and Jackson entered the residence. He said while the two of them were in the residence they made
 57 their way into a bedroom. He stated in the bedroom they found two shotguns, a handgun and an AK-47. He said they noticed cops outside the
 58 residence while looking out of a window in the bedroom. He advised Jackson made the statement, "I'm gonna roll this down like GTA" referring to the
 59 video game Grand Theft Auto. He stated Jackson fired the shotgun multiple times at the deputies who were outside the residence. [redacted] then said
 60 he noticed green dots on him so he fired a double barrel shotgun at the deputies as well. He said he fired the shotgun a couple times and also fired a
 61 handgun at the deputies. He told Detective McGuire he knew they were cops when he shot at them and shot to cause "harm" to them. [redacted] stated
 62 he and Jackson then ran into the garage and the garage door was open. He said before he ran to the garage, he had grabbed an AK-47 from the
 63 bedroom which was in a case. Also in the case were two loaded magazines for the AK-47.

64
 65 [redacted] said Jackson fired the shotgun at deputies from the garage. He advised he was behind her. He stated after Jackson fired at the deputies,
 66 they shot back and hit her multiple times. [redacted] stated he then fired the AK-47 at the deputies because they shot and "most likely" killed his friend.

68 He said he fired multiple rounds from the AK-47 and had to reload the second magazine. He stated after running out of ammunition from the second

69 magazine he was confronted by deputies and surrendered.

70

71 A search warrant was obtained for the residence, while collecting evidence for this investigation, it was obvious Jackson, and [redacted] did damage to

72 the interior and exterior of the residence. The main items destroyed at the residence by Jackson and [redacted] were the following: the master

73 bathroom's shower stall glass was shattered, the master bathroom's porcelain toilet was shattered, the master bathroom's large glass mirror was

74 shattered, and they damaged several interior walls (Jackson and [redacted] by creating holes into the drywall and carving things into them, four sliding

75 glass doors were shattered (each door was roughly 8 feet tall), the patio bathroom glass door was shattered, four windows were shattered, the

76 aluminum frame of patio screen was damaged, as well as 2 televisions (32" and 40") were gouged and cracked. The monetary value of the damage

77 done to the property inside and outside of 1050 Enterprise Osteen Road exceeded over \$1000.00. There were other items damaged and all of the

78 damage was documented and photographed by the Volusia Sheriff's Office Crime Scene Unit. During the execution of the search warrant 2 spent


79 (fired) shotgun shells and 4 spent 22 caliber casings were recovered from inside the residence, having been fired by the suspects. No spent AK-47

80 ammunition was located indicating that [redacted] did not actually fire any AK-47 rounds.

82 As a result of the evidence collected and the interviews conducted, arrest affidavits were drafted charging Jackson with attempted murder on a law

83 enforcement officer, armed burglary, and criminal mischief over \$1000.
