3. On May 11th, 2024, at approximately 2325 hours, Deputy Thomas responded to the [REDACTED], located
4. a [REDACTED] for the report of a physical altercation.
- 5.
6. Upon arrival, Deputy Thomas observed a male, later identified as Gregory Anglade, lying on his back
7. being held down by patrons. Patrons advised Deputy Thomas that the subject was in a physical altercation
8. with other subjects, causing a disturbance. Upon contact, Deputy Thomas was wearing an agency-issued
9. uniform, fitted with a sheriff badge and agency insignias, announcing himself as a Deputy with the
10. Sheriff's Office and attempted to secure Anglade. While deputies attempted to secure Anglade's hands
11. behind his back, Anglade continued to struggle, biting Deputy Thomas on the left side of his left hand,
12. As Deputy Thomas pulled his left hand away from Anglade, as Anglade attempted to bite Deputy Thomas's
13. right hand. Deputy Thomas gave a distraction strike to the left side of Anglades face, allowing Sergeant
14. Leven to secure Anglade's left arm behind his back. Deputies gave verbal commands to Anglade to release
15. his hands from underneath him, which he eventually complied with. Deputy Thomas secured Anglade in
16. the rear prisoner compartment of the patrol vehicle.

18. Deputies interviewed Natalie Snow who reported the following:
19. Anglade became upset when she denied him access to his car keys, due to him being highly intoxicated.
20. A verbal altercation ensued with Anglade and other patrons. Upon leaving the building a physical altercation
21. ensued where a public disturbance occurred. Anglade became highly agitated and was restrained on the
22. ground awaiting law enforcement's arrival.

24. Anglade was transported to the Volusia County Branch Jail.

26. It should be noted that Deputy Thomas sustained redness on the left side of his hand from being
27. bitten and did not need medical treatment.
