

Upon such expiration, the Clerk of the Court is directed to immediately unseal them and make them available to the public, to include online access to such records;
2. All other court records in this matter subject to seal under prior orders of this Court that

are not specifically identified in Paragraph 1 above shall be immediately unsealed as of the date of this Order and be made available to the public, to include online access to such records;

All parties recognize that the Defendant specifically reserves his right to seek a future court order to expunge and/or seal records in this matter, to the extent such expungement and/or sealing is authorized by law, and that this Order does not prejudice the Defendant's ability to seek such relief; and
4. The hearing set for November 5, 2020 at 11 a.m. in this matter is hereby cancelled.
